

REPORT ON ALUMNI FEEDBACK

The College continually involves the students to come forth and share their concerns about their institution. In order to make the academic environment of the college more student centric, the administration gathers feedbacks from students and alumni. Since students are the central stakeholders of the academic institution, their experiences on Academic resources, Extension services, Infrastructure, Institutional Social Responsibility activities and College Impact on students' life etc. are semester wise collected from the students.

The collected and compiled responses are 317 in quantitative terms for the year under report. The students have marked their experiences on a 5-point scale (excellent, very good, good, average and poor). Their responses have been stated in percentage terms (in the Table below). Their responses have highlighted that they are very satisfied with the Academic environment, resources and infrastructure of the college. Students are innately happy and satisfied with the developments in the College infrastructure and the rising student participation in academic, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities. The Library Facilities, Knowledge Resource Centre, Laboratories, Recreational Facilities, Facilities for Differently-abled Students, Sports Facilities, CCTV Surveillance System, Medical Facilities, Mentoring and Counselling are the key contributors to make the teaching-learning process more engaging and outcome based.

The table shows the students' responses about the Academic and infrastructure facilities in the College. The higher percentage responses towards the "excellent" and "very good" denotes that the College administration is making all efforts to ensure more resources for

students on a continuous basis by resolving the issues with the concerned students on a regular basis.

The major response rate has been witnessed towards the favorable College facilities for the students on several parameters. The students have addressed an Excellent response in terms of Fee Structure (59.62%), CCTV Surveillance System (58.36%), Facilities for Differently-abled Students (54.89%), Environment (54.89%), Counselling (52.37%), Knowledge Resource Centre (50.47%). The routine monitoring of College activities is taken care off by the CCTV Surveillance System installed in the entire campus. The students have also addressed that they find the premises to be safe after installation of system. Besides, the students have been closely mentored and counselled by the faculty members on regular basis. This endeavor has assisted and guided the students in their academic and career related dilemmas on a continuous basis. Also, the environmental concerns have been often addressed by the College and numerous awareness initiatives have been launched by the College. The students have favorably responded towards this development and they have keenly participated in the Tree plantation drives, say no to plastic campaign etc. during the year under report. The administration has always addressed the concerns about inclusive education in terms of access to resources. Hence, the Facilities for Differently-abled Students has made the classroom more inclusive for the students. The IT network usage has also drawn enormous attention of the learners. The projector installed classrooms and wi-fi enabled campus has made teaching pedagogy more student focused. The degree of ease and accessibility of these resources has been a step towards inculcating the academic brilliance among the pupils.

On a parallel front, IT Network, Sports Facilities, Medical Facilities, Laboratories, Bank, and Recreational Facilities have also been appreciated by the stakeholders. They endorse the fact that the resources in the campus have succeeded to equip them for the welfare of students. Conclusively, the students have explicitly claimed the rising excellence of College for the betterment of academic environment. The alumni of the College have also responded positively towards the infrastructural advancements that have improved the overall academic environment of the college. The Students' feedback has been a pivotal source of improvement but this is nowhere the end of the story, it's a part of the story. The responses are heard and resolved collectively. They are the impetus for College to evolve and excel with times.
