RESEARCH & INNOVATION

1. International Conferences

> International Conference on Bhartiya Business Practices: A Roadmap to Sustainability

A Two-day International Conference on Bharatiya Business Practices: A Roadmap to Future Sustainability was jointly organized by the Department of Commerce, Centre for Skill Development & IQAC in collaboration with ICSSR on 17th-18th April, 2023 at Shyam Lal College. Further, in the year of G-20 Presidency, India aspires the world to observe Life (Lifestyle for Environment) which is a behaviour-based movement that draws from our India's rich, ancient sustainable traditions to convince consumers, and inturn markets, to adopt environmentally-conscious practices. With these ideas in the backdrop, the conference focused on exploring novel ideas, exposed practical applications of theories through real life examples of Bhartiya Business Practices. The Conference comprised of one Workshop, two Plenary Session, nine Concurrent Sessions along with Inaugural address and Valedictory session. The Inaugural session witnessed the gracious presence of Chief Guest CS Manish Gupta (President, ICSI) and keynote speakers Prof. Kaisa Sorsa (Turku University of Applied Sciences, Finland), Prof. Keijo Varis (Turku University of Applied Sciences, Finland) and Prof. Rabi Narayan Kar (Principal, SLC). Around 88 participants attended the inaugural session including the participants, paper presenters and the managing team. A total of 68 papers were received out of which 44 papers were selected for presentation in their respective concurrent sessions. The Plenary and Concurrent Sessions were graced by sustainable development experts and academicians such as Prof. Munim K. Barai (Ritsumeikan Asia Pacific University, Japan), Sh. Rajeev K. Saxena (Director, Mazars, India), Prof. Anil Kumar Swain (Utkal University, India), Prof. Ari Lindeman (South-Eastern Finland University of Applied Science, Finland), Prof. S.S. Khanka (School of Management & Entrepreneurship, Delhi Technological University), Prof. Amitabh Gupta (Department of Finance & Business Economics, University of Delhi) that complemented the theme of the conference. The Conference had offered an opportunity for academicians and researchers to present and discuss their recent scholarly work, and discover new and interesting developments in this field.

> International Conference on Indian Knowledge System: Integration and Internationalization

IQAC and Saraswati IKS Centre, Shyam Lal College, University of Delhi organised a two-day International Conference in collaboration with ICSSR and AICTE commemorating

75 years of Independence. The two day conference on "Indian knowledge system: Integration and Internationalisation" held on 14-15 July 2022 includes workshops, two plenary sessions, nine paper presentations (concurrent sessions) along with an Inaugural and a Valedictory session. The two days' conference endeavors to revisit the India's age old knowledge traditions and find out the ways to inculcate them in contemporary educational system as envisaged in the National Education Policy (NEP), 2020. The inaugural session of the conference hosted Prof. Srinivas Varkhedi (Vice-Chancellor, Central University of Sanskrit, New Delhi) and Dr. Anuradha Choudhary (Coordinator, IKS Division of MoE, AICTE). The Conference has been attended by 132 participants including students, scholars, faculty members and academicians. The subsequent plenary session based on the theme "Indian Knowledge System as a Living Tradition", hosted three the speakers- Prof Munim Barai (Ritsumeikan Asia Pacific University, Japan), Prof VK Kaul (Former Dean and professor, University of Delhi) and Dr Anuradha Choudhary. The main aim of this conference was to imbibe "The Cultural and Spiritual Identity of India" and "Relevance of Indian Knowledge System in Present Academic System".

2. DBT Sponsored Star College Scheme

In 2020, Shyam Lal College has been awarded with financial grant for three years by Department of Biotechnology, Government of India, under the illustrious DBT Star College Scheme for strengthening education, training and research at undergraduate level for two departments of our college i.e., Chemistry and Physics. In the past three years, the college has successfully implemented various objectives of the scheme by:

- Strengthening academic and physical infrastructure for achieving excellence in teaching and training: Under the aegis of this scheme, the departments have greatly improved and updated existing library and laboratory resources via procurement of core and new instrumental techniques and curricular books in large numbers.
- Enhancing the quality of thinking, learning and teaching process: In addition to the existing practicals, students have been given hands-on-exposure to new beyond-the-curricular practicals and project work. This has motivated the students towards pursuing higher studies and building up a career in scientific research and development. On this note, a five days-long 'Hands on Scientific Software Training Programme' was organized where the participants were given hands on training on different scientific softwares which are an integral part of scientific research. After having immense appreciation and participation from students and faculty members, a 30 hour long Inter College 'Short Term Certificate Course' on 'Preparation & Application of Magnetic Nanoparticles and Hands-on Software Training' was also organized.
- Promoting networking and strengthening ties with other institutions via organization of conferences/seminars/workshops/lectures: With an aim to bring together teachers, professors, young budding researchers and students on a common platform to share and

learn knowledge in current research areas, the departments keep on organizing such activities. To mention some most recent and notable ones, National and International Webinars on 'Sustainable Polymers', 'Water Quality Assessment of Indian Rivers', 'Sustainable Circular Economy: A Solution to Global Issues', 'Entanglement Entropy and Holography', One-Week National Workshop on 'Emerging Trends in Science and Technology: Issues in this Unprecedented Times' and a three days-long interactive workshop for Intermediate school students "Gaming with Physics" were organized. In addition to this, the college also organized an Outreach Programme on 'Virtual Workshop on Laboratory Set-Up' under the aegis of Vidya Vistar Project and DBT Star College Scheme with Kalahandi University, Odisha.

- ➤ Giving exposure to practical scale up in industries and research laboratories: The College always attempts to organize any field/industrial visits. Recently, an industrial visit was made to Yakult Danone, Sonipat where a batch of 42 students of BSc (H) Chemistry and BSc Physical Science along with faculty members and lab staff visited the manufacturing plant.
- ➤ Optimizing technical capabilities of faculty and lab staff: The department keeps on conducting various faculty development programmes/lab-skill training programmes. A week-long Inter College 'Hands on Capacity Building Training Workshop for Non-Teaching Staff' was organized. A total of 30 non-teaching staff members participated from various colleges of Delhi University.

SLC (University of Delhi), Shyam Lal College is a participating institute in the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA 2.0) which is the flagship programme of MoE, GoI. Under this project, SLC has adopted 5 villages - Dhitora (Baghpat), Nithora (Ghaziabad), Chirodi (Ghaziabad), Jawli (Ghaziabad), Kotwalpur (Ghaziabad) to support rural development through institutional linkages. The Unnat Bharat Abhiyan team comprises of faculty members and student members of SLC who have conducted extensive surveys of the said villages, participated in the Swachata hi Sewa campaign, interacted with villagers and other stakeholders of the villages such as village Pradhans and village panchayat samities and other stakeholders.

University Chef & Skill India

SLC is proud to be the flag bearer of one-of-its kind programme - the 'University Chef'. The initiative is in tandem with Government's 'Skill India' programme. This unique effort is a step to enhance the creativity and application of precise thought process among the students. The inter-college Event is an inception by the Principal, Prof. Rabi Narayan Kar who provided all the required encouragement to the participants. It invites passionate cooks from various universities to compete against each other in culinary challenges to showcase and develop their cooking skills and win the title of the best chef. The gala event is one of the most awaited events of the University and has won acclaim from all, including celebrated chefs like Nita Mehta. It is the only event in the university which gives an opportunity to the young Chefs of India to showcase their cooking prowess. This year University Chef (Edition 6) was held on February 16-17, 2023.

BEST PRACTICES

1. SAP (Swachhta Action Plan) Under MoE

SLC has achieved another remarkable milestone with Ministry of Education recognizing SLC as SAP (Swachhta Action Plan) institution in 2020. Under this scheme, SLC has undertaken to work towards essential swachhta activities including sanitation and hygiene, waste management, water management, energy management and greenery. To achieve the above tasks, the College has formed committees that are actively charting out plans to work in the defined areas for maximum benefit of the institution and its stakeholders.

2. Adoption of Villages

SLC is a participating institute in the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan and has adopted 5 villages in Uttar Pradesh: Dhitora (Baghpat), Nithora (Ghaziabad), Chirodi (Ghaziabad), Jawli (Ghaziabad), Kotwalpur (Ghaziabad). Under this initiative, the UBA team has conducted extensive surveys of the said villages and interacted with villagers and other stakeholders of the villages such as village Pradhans and village panchayat samities and other stakeholders. The village visits, surveys conducted, data collected and interactions with villagers and concerned stakeholders of the villages have helped the team to shortlist problem areas for further assistance. The SLC team planned and executed awareness campaigns for financial literacy including availing government financial incentives and schemes, insurance plan and health insurance, workshops for awareness around sanitation issues in the villages, campaigns about conservation of water, waste management, non-use of polythene, distribution of cloth bags and practical solution for proper waste management.

3. Student Mentorship Programme

SLC has successfully implemented mentorship programme through IQAC of the College, for all the students. Under this full-fledged mentorship programme, all the students are assigned to designated faculty members during their stay in the college.

4. Powered by Renewable Energy

The Solar Power plant of the College is fully functional and generates power covering 45% of our peak demand. The Solar Power plant, installed in the college, is a collaborative initiative with IPGCL, Govt. of NCT of Delhi wherein the said govt. agency has borne the full cost of the installation of the Solar panels in the college. We have been saving power as well as financial resources since the plant became fully functional. The College also practices regular switch off drives so as to save and conserve energy.

5. East Delhi Flower Show

SLC holds another pioneer event every year - the East Delhi Flower Show. SLC Flower Show hosts colleges, schools and nurseries of the East Delhi that showcase their floral varieties and

species in the month of February every year. This year also, SLC organized flagship event of "Umang-East Delhi Flower Show 4.0" on 28th February, 2022 in its campus. Garden committee of SLC in collaboration with Eco-Club, Swachhta Action Plan (SAP) and IQAC actively organised several competitions namely Best out of waste, Eco-Friendly Rangoli and Photography and Videography competition to encourage students to show their creativity and promote eco-friendly activities. In the best out of waste competition, students were encouraged to use organic waste.

6. Remedial Classes

SLC regularly conducts remedial classes, every semester, for students in all the departments that largely benefit students in resolving their doubts and difficulties related to their respective courses and papers.

7. Institution's Innovation Council

SLC established Innovation Council (IIC) under MoE's, GOI Innovation Cell, an initiative launched in November, 2018. The primary mandate of Innovation Cell, MoE, GOI is to encourage, inspire and nurture young students by supporting them to work with new ideas. SLC's Innovation Council works towards inculcating the spirit of innovation among students, and develop a start-up ecosystem. In IIC, students participate in mentoring sessions, workshops and innovative idea competitions. Since its inception, the IIC, SLC has produced and developed very promising startup ideas such as Sajagta, Steam Power generator, Infollege, and Abhikalpana etc. Four SLC faculty members have successfully completed the Ambassador Training Programme conducted by Innovation Cell, MoE, GOI and it has received 3 stars since its establishment.

8. Skill Based Courses

Skill Development Centre, SLC started Add-on Certificate and Diploma courses in foreign languages in 2018 under the aegis of Department of Germanic & Romanic Studies, University of Delhi. SLC also runs several courses in collaboration with reputed national institutions. The College received overwhelming response for this maiden endeavor and has since been successfully running the following Certificate and Diploma courses:

- Certificate course in Foreign Language: German/Spanish/French (Affiliated to Department of Germanic and Romanic Studies, University of Delhi)
- Certificate course in stock trading "Mastering the Stock Market" in collaboration with BSE Institute Ltd.
- Diploma in Foreign Language: German/Spanish/French (Affiliated to Department of Germanic and Romanic Studies, University of Delhi)
- Advance Diploma in Foreign Language: Chinese/Japanese/Korean (Affiliated to Department of East Asian Studies, University of Delhi)

- Fundamental course in Artificial Intelligence and Machine learning-NIELIT
- Fundamental course in Office Automation NIELIT
- Fundamental course in Digital and Social Media Marketing-NIELIT

Certificate courses in Indian Knowledge System, Spoken English, and Courses on Computer Concepts (CCC), Fundamental course in Office Administration, Big Data and Hadoop are expected to commence shortly.

9. Green Initiatives

Conservation of environment has been the focus of College. The students and faculty members of the College work in coordination to cultivate and preserve a green environment.

- The college is a tobacco-free, smoke-free zone and has said a loud 'NO' to crackers and plastic bags.
- > The tree plantation activities organized by the College are aimed at improving the air quality in and around the College, as well as for creating awareness about protection of environment.
- The College takes special care to inculcate the habit of switching off fans and lights when these are not in use.
- All garden waste is used for making compost in compost pits.
- The college promotes energy saving initiatives and encourages all stakeholders to use battery power vehicle.
- ▶ Burning of garden waste is strictly prohibited on the Campus to minimize air pollution.
- ➤ E-waste is routed through appropriate channels for proper disposal.
- In order to ensure safe drinking water, the College has installed ROs in the campus.
- The college has developed pedestrian friendly pathways. All are encouraged to use the same
- College also engages in tree plantation in and around the campus.
- > Renewable energy in the college is also an important focus area.
- ➤ College made efforts for carbon neutrality, with large green-patches, gardens, and a vast collection of trees.
- College has installed three LED screens to communicate with students and faculty to reduce the use of paper in printing official notices etc.
- ➤ The College is increasingly shifting to the use of LED lights.

- E-waste generated in the campus is managed as per the E-Waste Management through a committee. The E-waste is disposed off to authorized recyclers.
- The Garden Committee attempts to ensure the use of natural fertilizers and natural material for supporting plants and climbers.

10. Rain Water Harvesting

As the institution is committed to zero water wastage and harnessing, the power of every drop of this precious commodity, SLC has taken important measure like rain water harvesting system.

11. Recycling Papers

SLC is sensitive towards the cause of conserving natural resources and promotes the culture of respecting nature. SLC, in collaboration with NGO Jaagruti, has started recycling of waste papers and in return has received numerous reams of paper.

12. LED Lights

The usage of LED lights has reduced the power consumption heavily. The installation of LED lights following the installation of solar panels has helped the College to save its financial resources. In addition to it, switch-off drills are carried on regular basis to make the SLCians aware and alert regarding energy consumption and saving.

13. Sewage Treatment Plant

The college has sewage treatment plant of capacity 75000 L which is fully operational.

14. Assessment and Feedback

The College has also successfully implemented the structured feedback system that ensures that the concerns of the students are heard and addressed. So far, we have successfully completed five cycles of taking holistic feedback from the students that have been analysed and the issues related to academics, infrastructure and facilities raised have been addressed. Along with this, the IQAC also takes feedback on curriculum from different stakeholders. The action taken report is subsequently prepared and discussed with the different departments.

15. Counselling Services

The Head of the institution regularly meets and interacts with students via virtual platform in order to resolve their queries regarding uncertainty of the academic session due to the pandemic situation. Counselling Services have been activated with professional counsellor and doctor to address students' anxiety and other issues. The college also regularly organizes counselling sessions for students through ICC and WDC. The Principal follows the open door policy and is always available to students during office hours. The College has a very active

mentoring mechanism in which teachers mentor and regularly meet their mentee (students) in order to resolve their academic and other concerns. During the COVID-19 pandemic, the college also facilitated the mobile data recharge of students' phones so that they do not miss out on interactions and classes with teachers.

16. Opportunities for Under-Privileged Children in Vicinity

SLC aims at promotion and improvement of sports and games in trans-Yamuna region of Delhi by providing opportunities and best coaching facilities to the young and talented players of the society. The endeavor is to provide a platform to young talented players with state-of-the-art amenities so that they learn, train and improve their standard in sports and games, and excel at the international and national level. For the purpose, the college has taken a new initiative to provide free and regular coaching in the above mentioned games to deserving and talented students from neighboring schools. The aim is also to promote indigenous games among the youth who are in some ways unaware of the vast career possibilities to be explored in our national games and sports.

17. Digital Practices

The College has already adopted digital practices in all office and students related work. IQAC collaborates with various departments to organize virtual lectures and talks and interviews of imminent personalities across the world. The College also encourages the faculty to record lectures through screen cast-o-matic v2.0 software for future reference and benefit of the students.

The Administration took the digitalization one step further by transfiguring the students' I-cards into Single Sign-on (SSO) card. This card bearing bar-code is an in-house product developed by the technical team of the college. This one stop card is revolutionary as it makes the entire data just one click away and so is less time- consuming with minimum chances of being faulty and ensures better access to the on-campus facilities like:

- ➤ *Issuing books in library* the students can issue books with the help of SSO card and they would not require any separate library card.
- Security- It makes screening easier on special days like student elections, College fest, annual function etc. to avoid any scuffles and untoward incidents in the campus.
- Payment of bills- the College is also thinking of creating a pay wallet which will be connected with students' account so as to make their campus experience better. The Administration is virtually in touch with the non-teaching staff all the time during office hours. All the officials of the College are connected with the Principal through Google worksheet where routine jobs are assigned to concerned officials and are routinely monitored.

The College teaching staff is always updated with real-time LED display in the staff room which is used for the display of time-table and other important notices.

18. Inclusive Education and Development

The practice of Inclusive Education and Development continues from the last year as it serves meaningful benefit for the students. Since the location of the College is very strategic, the students from NCR/North-East Delhi get the maximum benefit of studying in a premier Delhi University College. The College gives value-based education to the students (as is the vision of the College) and also takes care of the professionalism of the Industry/market and prepares the students for the competitive world outside. Remedial classes, workshops organized by different departments, Placement Cell and Skill Development Cell, industry interaction through CII give the students enough exposure and feel of the professional world.

19. Community Outreach Programme

SLC is actively sensitive to its Institutional Social Responsibility and promotes institution-neighbourhood-community initiatives and outreach programs through its various activities that broadly fall under NCC/NSS/WDC/EOC/Sports. SLC is surrounded by many underdeveloped, overpopulated and minority community localities, and so becomes the sole facilitator, in the area, of achieving academic excellence for students belonging to economically backward classes and minority communities. The following are the community outreach steps that the college facilitates:

- The College has NCC, NSS, Women Development Cell, Centre for Holistic Development, Centre for Industry Interaction and Skill Development, Ambedkar Study Circle, Gandhi Study Circle etc. which organize events dedicated towards community service like blood donation camp, tree plantation drive, Save Yamuna Campaign, gender sensitization, identity discourses, moral education etc. to enhance the sense of community feeling and citizenship among the students.
- > SLC has also adopted Shahdara mandi and regularly conducts cleanliness drives cleanliness drives, switch over to cashless trading and plastic free campaigns.
- The College promotes sports and games in the trans-Yamuna region of Delhi by providing opportunities and best coaching facilities to the young and talented players from low-income groups or underprivileged sections of society.
- ➤ The College has conducted various surveys in the past, including the survey as part of the project 'Old Age Homes in Delhi Understanding the Challenges Faced by Them and Their Contribution to the Society'. The primary objective of this project is to have a closer view at the old age homes functioning in Delhi in order to assess the problems and challenges that these institutions are facing.

- NSS volunteers of the College visit slum areas and spread awareness about cleanliness in collaboration with NGOs. The tree plantation activities organized by the College are aimed at improving the air quality in and around the College, as well as for creating awareness about protection of environment.
- WDC regularly organises activities to sensitize the students and staff to gender related issues and to promote respect for human beings irrespective of race, religion, colour or gender.
- Most of the activities of the Equal Opportunities Cell such as remedial classes and Spoken English classes for students from under-privileged communities and facilities for differently abled also largely benefit the students from surrounding areas.
- > The College participates in all national initiatives aimed at promoting good citizenship such as cleanliness drive, skill and entrepreneurship development initiatives, "Make in India" campaign, etc.
- The College has set up Centre for Skill Development following the launch of this programme by the Union Government.
- ➤ SLC has adopted 5 villages under UBA project under MoE, GOI.
- ➤ The NSS of the College also regularly organizes "Nirbheek" One week Women self-defense camp for girl students. The UBA team and NSS team of the College has already conducted cleanliness drives in Yamuna Bazaar Ghat no 21. The Development and Maintenance of Ghat No.-21 has been done along with repairing, beautification, restructuring, painting and colouring work.
- The NSS wing of the College lives up to its motto "Love All and Serve All". The students engaged with NSS volunteer with a number of NGOs. They also organize clothes donation drives to support NGOs like Amar Jyoti. The NSS, every year, organizes a blood donation camp in the College. NCC girls of SLC have participated and organized Self-defense Camp, Yoga Camp, Tree Plantation drive and save Yamuna Campaign'.
- The College also provides fee concession, financial aid, book aid, awards and prizes to students from underprivileged sections of society.
- The Enactus team of the College has worked on community outreach projects like "PRAYOJYA" (2018). The project is an effort to reduce plastic pollutants in our surrounding by transforming them from waste plastic bottles to useful and decorative plastic utensils and simultaneously providing employment to women from underprivileged communities and train them in the art of making different kinds of decorative stuff with plastic.
- Various centres of SLC viz. Innovation, E-cell, CSD of the college collaborated with several research institutes and departments to explore the student's latent skills and also

conducted field trips, industrial and educational visits. Women Development Centre (WDC) in collaboration with National Service Scheme (NSS) and Swachhta Action Plan (SAP) of SLC organised awareness program on "Menstrual Hygiene Awareness Campaign".

20. Yamuna Festival 3.0

The Annual Cultural festival 'Yamuna Mahotsav' on the college campus and at Yamuna Ghat is an attempt to honour the Yamuna River, the lifeline of our city. It tries to increase public knowledge about Yamuna River preservation and revitalization among students and the general public. At the Yamuna Ghat No. 21 near Yamuna Bazaar (Kashmiri Gate), NSS, and the Eco Club held a plantation drive and Cleaniness Campaign. This used to be followed by a pledge to protect the river and an eco-friendly aarti. The Fine Arts Society, NSS, and Eco Club worked with IQAC to put up the festival. At the plantation, a clean-up campaign and a pledge to protect the river were held. Students also put up a stall to display eco-friendly products like handmade lamps (Diyas) and plastic-based plant pots, bird houses etc.

INFRASTRUCTURE

- College has undertaken major infrastructural upgradation with construction of 2nd Floor in the old building with several new classrooms, Multipurpose Hall and Computer Labs.
- Installation of Public Address System in MPH.
- College has completed and operationalized STP plant.
- Construction of Covered Central Stage with modern amenities is underway.
- Construction of bigger Ampitheatre work is completed.
- Renovation, expansion and centralized AC work of Library with modern amenities is completed.
- ➤ Green grass carpeting work is completed in college grounds.
- ➤ All three gates of the college have been upgraded as per the needs of PWBD students.
- Completed underground pipe line work for irrigation of college gardens.
- Repair and renovation work has been completed in college premises.
- ➤ New and fresh interlocking paver work is completed in the campus.
- Reinstallation of solar modules work at the roof of college building is completed.
- Repair and renovation work of aluminium almirah in Physics and Chemistry Lab is completed.

UNIVERSITY EXAMINATION RESULTS & SCHOLARSHIP

Once agin, this year, our students have performed exceptionally well and a good number of students qualified with first divisions in the examinations. Out of 3008 students who appeared in the semester examination conducted during 2021-22, 3003 passed giving a pass percentage of 99.83%. An important aspect worth highlighting here is that when we look at the result of 1st year students; 917 of the 920 students passed, giving 99.67% success rate, 2nd year students; 1133 of the 1135 students passed, giving 99.82% success rate and 3rd year students; 953 of the 953 students passed, giving 100% success rate. 96.54% of the students have secured first division in the third year and this has been gradually increasing over the years.

I extend my heartiest congratulations to all the students for their creditable performance in the University Examinations and for keeping the banner of SLC flying high on the academic front.

The Internal Complaints Committee organized a virtual talk, "Empowering Young Minds: Law and Its Implications" on 10th December, 2022 at 3.00 p.m. Mr. Sangram Patnaik, an eminent lawyer, who specializes in civil and corporate law, was invited to address the students and the faculty members. The talk focused on creating awareness

about the PoSH or "Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013", meant to create safe and secure (work) places for women, and women's rights under this Act. The speaker began by emphasizing the importance of legal literacy for young women in dealing with challenges posed by gender-based inequality and violence. As more and more young women step out for education and work, they have to deal with casual acts of sexism/harassment as well as more extraordinary situations. Therefore, a basic knowledge of their rights and mechanisms for redressal under law is essential. Mr. Patnaik explained the relevance of the PoSH Act and its provisions, particularly, in the context of institutes of higher education to the audience. He went on to address the questions and concerns raised by members of the audience, some of them also shared their own experiences.
