SLC in the Academic Session 2020-21

The academic session 2020-21 has seen unprecedented academic and infrastructural developments in the college. The whole SLC team including teachers, students and the non-teaching staff works towards promoting higher education with a view to encourage a more 'learner-centric' approach. SLC strives to achieve these goals through regular curricular monitoring, academic innovations and continuous student involvement in all the College activities.

I proudly announce that our college has achieved rank 69th rank in 2020, in the MoE, GOI NIRF ranking of colleges in India. With this achievement, SLC has been, consecutively for 3 years, in the top 100 colleges of India. I want to congratulate all my teacher colleagues, non-teaching staff and students for this achievement and I am sure of the continued hard work and perseverance of my colleagues so that we achieve better laurels in the years to come.

I am very happy to announce that the College has been selected under the DBT Govt. of India Star College Scheme in 2019-20 for the Department of Chemistry and Physics.

We are happy to announce that the second batch of our newly introduced courses – B.Sc (Hons) Chemistry and Mathematics have been successfully promoted this year. Further, the introduction of New (Hons) courses in Computer Science, Operational Research, Botany and Physics are pending for approval with University of Delhi. SLC is also pursuing with the University of Delhi for postgraduate courses in Commerce, English, Economics, History and Political Science.

We are also running an add on Certificate course on "Mastering the Stock Market" in collaboration with Bombay Stock Exchange Ltd. which has successfully completed four batches. The college also offered value added courses on Yoga and Holistic Development, Research Analytics, Introduction to Artificial Intelligence, Bitcoin and Blockchain Technology and Virtual Interaction and Marketing. In addition to this, the College has also begun Foreign Language Diploma and Certificate Courses under the aegis of Department of Germanic & Romance Studies, University of Delhi. The Unnat Bharat Abhiyaan(UBA) and Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of SLC in collaboration with Shiksha Sanskriti Utthan Nyas (SSUN) organized a National Student Seminar on “National Education Policy(Nep) 2020 – A New Paradigm to Empower India”. The seminar was conducted on February 16, 2021 in the College Seminar Hall with participants physically present in the college (including faculty and students) and a huge no. of

participants joined on virtual platform Zoom and Facebook. The Seminar comprised of an Inaugural Session, one Plenary Session and three Parallel Sessions with students' paper presentations. The seminar was inaugurated by Shri. Atul Kothari Ji (National Secretary, Shiksha Sanskriti Utthan Nyas) with Prof. P.C. 3. *Academic Innovations*

Academic Initiatives during Covid-19 Pandemic

SLC has taken several academically innovative initiatives during the current Covid-19 pandemic situation. The faculty members at SLC are dedicated to their work and are actively engaged in providing necessary support to the students in the Covid-19 pandemic time and the subsequent lockdown. The college faculty members are using following ways and platforms to engage with students towards continuing teaching-learning process:

- Popularizing the Virtual Lab for the benefits of the students
- Student’s engagements through Live Projects.
- Multi-Disciplinary Idea Generation Competitions from students
- Co-Creation, Co-Sharing of knowledge and dissemination by engaging experts from different fields etc.
- Uploading e-resources on college website for student perusal.
- The students access e-resources uploaded by their teachers.

- Engagement of student classes through online platforms like Google Meet and Google Classroom. Teachers engage the students throughout via Zoom, Webex, Skype etc. for innovative, deliberations, competitions and meaningful mentoring.
- The online class sessions are recorded and sent to students who are unable to join the same.
- The faculty members also use Google classrooms to upload PDF files and videos and solve student queries using Chatroom options.
- Teachers have used Google forms for taking tests, projects and assignments.
- The College has made available online reading material to all the students through N-list portal for which all students have been given login and password.
- The College has also provided link on the college website for the reading material made available by the Delhi University library system and SOL.
- The incumbent holds weekly meetings with the TICs via virtual platforms during the Covid-19 for monitoring the smooth functioning of the teaching-learning process and other academic and administrative matters.
- The College also started a helpline for students to help in data recharge of the mobile phones of those students who could not afford data recharge and were, thus, unable to attend online classes and complete assignments.
- The college has also organized series of Webinars and online discussions on various topics of contemporary relevance.
- The college has reached out to the students who have lost their parents during the severe Covid-19 second wave in April 2021 by initiating a project *Anutosh*. College has provided immediate counselling from professional counsellor, mentored them towards a safe and professionally secure future and also helping them in academic and other needs.

4. *Interdisciplinary Student Projects and Student Development Programmes*

Every year, the students of SLC get an opportunity to explore new areas of research in the realm of multi-disciplinary and socially relevant areas. On similar lines, SLC started Interdisciplinary Student Research Projects in 2018. Research project proposals are invited from students across different courses. The projects so received are scrutinized and shortlisted under a rigorous process. The shortlisted projects are presented before external expert academics from scientific fields. Best Practices

1. SAP (Swachhta Action Plan) Under MoE

SLC has achieved an other remarkable milestone with Ministry of Education recognizing SLC as SAP (Swachhta Action Plan) institution in 2020.

2. Adoption of Villages

SLC is a participating institute in the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan and has adopted 5 villages in Uttar Pradesh: Dhitora (Baghpat), Nithora (Ghaziabad), Chirodi (Ghaziabad), Jawli (Ghaziabad), Kotwalpur (Ghaziabad). Under this initiative, the UBA team has conducted extensive surveys of the said villages and interacted with villagers and other stakeholders of the villages such as village Pradhans and village panchayat samities and other stakeholders. The visits and fieldwork happened between August and November, 2019. The surveys conducted and the interactions revealed issues with water logging during rainy season, issues with garbage disposal in the absence of proper waste disposal system, no Senior Secondary School and hospital in the village.

The village visits, surveys conducted, data collected and interactions with villagers and concerned stakeholders of the villages have helped the team to shortlist problem areas for further assistance. The SLC team planned and executed awareness campaigns for financial literacy including availing government financial incentives and schemes, insurance plans and health insurance, workshops for awareness around sanitation issues in the villages, campaigns about conservation of water, waste management, non-use of polythene, distribution of cloth bags and practical solution for proper waste management.

The college has also taken up the task of helping the ones in distress and to reach out to the villages during Covid – 19 pandemic. As part of our social responsibility as an academic institution and on humanitarian grounds too, the College emerged as a flagbearer in spreading awareness about the probable reasons for the spread of Covid19, its likely implications and what measures to be undertaken to reduce its consequences. A WhatsApp group with members from the villages like the Pradhans, village elders and officials has been formed to spread awareness about the do's and don't during this pandemic and the national lockdown. The student members made handmade soap and distributed them in their neighbourhood so as to help people maintain good hygiene and fight this chronic disease. The College is actively involved in food distribution among the poor and the homeless. The college volunteers also distributed masks in the villages and the adjoining areas of college. Hundreds of masks were not only distributed free of cost but even the villagers were apprised of the ways to use and dispose off the same.

3. Student Mentoring Programme

SLC has successfully implemented mentoring programme through IQAC of the college, for all the students. Under this full-fledged mentoring programme, Students, in the group of 25, are assigned to designated faculty members during their stay in the college.

4. Powered by Renewable Energy

The Solar Power Plant of the College is fully functional and generates power for our consumption and whenever there is any surplus it goes back to Delhi homes. The Solar Power Plant, installed in the college, is a collaborative initiative with IPGCL, Govt. of NCT of Delhi. We have been saving power as well as financial resources since the plant became fully functional. The College also practices regular switch off drives so as to save and conserve energy.

5. East Delhi Flower Show 2021

SLC organised flagship event of “Umang-East Delhi Flower Show 3.0” on March 1, 2021 in its campus to encourage the spirit of Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat & Swachha Bhart Abhiyan in collaboration with Eco Club and Garden committee and the Special attraction was opportunity for Nurseries, handmade art and craft. Hon’ble Vice Chancellor Prof. P.C. Joshi graced the occasion and addressed the gathering along with Hon’ble Chairperson, SLC Governing body Smt. Savita Gupta, Dean of Colleges Prof. Balram Pani. Ecoclub students not only participated in flower show but also exhibited some craft work made out of waste. They made some creative and useful things from the waste. They even made some different kind of Bird nest from the waste material.

6. Relaxation of admission cutoff % for Girl Students

The College is located in an area of the city densely populated by under-privileged sections of society. SLC's policy of giving preference to the girl students in the Admissions with 1% relaxation in admission percentage calculation, is largely aimed at correcting the gender bias/disparity in the neighbourhood and community.

7. Remedial Classes

SLC regularly conducts remedial classes, every semester, for students from under-privileged communities that largely benefit the students from surrounding areas.

8. Innovation Council

SLC established Innovation Council (IC) under MoE's, GOI Innovation Cell, an initiative launched in November of 2018. The primary mandate of Innovation Cell, MoE, GOI is to encourage, inspire and nurture young students by supporting them to work with new ideas. SLC's Innovation Council works towards inculcating the spirit of innovation among students, and develop a start up ecosystem. In IC, students participate in mentoring sessions, workshops and innovative idea competitions. Since its inception, the IC, SLC has produced and developed very promising startup ideas such as Sajagta, Steam Power generator, Infollege, and Abhikalpana etc. SLC faculty members (4) have successfully completed the Ambassador Training Programme conducted by Innovation Cell, MoE, GOI and it has received 2 stars since its establishment.

9. Skill based Courses

Skill Development Centre, SLC started Add-On Certificate and Diploma courses in Foreign languages in 2018 under the aegis of Department of Germanic & Romance Studies, Department of East Asian Studies, University of Delhi.

The following Certificate and Diploma courses are offered by the college:

- Certificate course in four Foreign Language: German/Spanish/French/Japanese (Affiliated to Department of Germanic and Romance Studies, University of Delhi)
- Certificate course in stock trading “Mastering the Stock Market” in collaboration with BSE Institute Ltd. C.
- Diploma in Foreign Language: German/Spanish/French (Affiliated to Department of Germanic and Romance Studies, University of Delhi)
- Certificate course in Foreign Language: Chinese/Japanese/Korean (Affiliated to Department of East Asian Studies, University of Delhi)

10. Green Initiative

Conservation of environment has been the focus of the College. The students, faculty, office staff and other staff of the College work in coordination to cultivate and preserve a green environment.

- The College is a tobacco-free, smoke-free zone and has said a loud ‘NO’ to crackers and plastic bags.
- The tree plantation activities organized by the College are aimed at improving the air quality in and around the College, as well as for creating awareness about protection of environment.
- The College takes special care to inculcate the habit of switching off fans and lights when these are not in use.
- All garden waste is used for making compost in compost pits.
- Burning of garden waste is strictly prohibited on the Campus to minimize air pollution.
- E-waste is routed through appropriate channels for proper disposal
- The College also engages in regular tree plantation drives in and around the campus.
- The College took efforts for carbon neutrality, with large green-patches, gardens and a vast collection of trees.

- The College has installed three LED screens to communicate with students and faculty to reduce the use of paper in printing official notices etc.
- The Garden Committee attempts to ensure the use of natural fertilizers and natural material for supporting plants and climbers.

11. Rain Water Harvesting

As an institution committed to zero water wastage and harnessing the power of every drop of this precious commodity, SLC has taken important measure like installing rain water harvesting system in the campus.

12. Recycling Papers

SLC is sensitive towards the cause of conserving natural resources and promotes the culture of respecting nature. SLC in collaboration with NGO Jagriti recycles waste paper and in return receives reams of paper.

13. LED Lights

The usage of LED lights has reduced the power consumption heavily. The installation of LED lights following the installation of solar panels has helped the College save its financial resources. In addition to this, switch-off drills are carried out on regular basis to make the SLCians aware and alert regarding energy consumption and saving.

14. Assessment and Feedback

The College has also successfully implemented the structured feedback system that ensures that the concerns of the students are heard and addressed. So far we have successfully completed two cycles of taking holistic feedback from the students that have been analyzed and the issues related to academics, infrastructure and facilities raised have been addressed. Along with this, the IQAC also takes feedback on curriculum from different stakeholders. The action taken report is subsequently prepared and discussed with the different departments.

15. Opportunities for neighbourhood Under-Privileged School Children to Participate/Coaching Facility for Different Games

Shyam Lal College is the foremost college in East Delhi Campus of the University of Delhi with outstanding sports facilities for games like Hockey, Baseball, Volleyball, Judo and Kabaddi. The College aims at promotion and improvement of sports and games in trans-Yamuna region of Delhi by providing opportunities and best coaching facilities to the young and talented players of the society. The college has taken this initiative to provide free and regular coaching in the above mentioned games to deserving and talented students from neighboring schools. The aim is also to promote indigenous games among the youth who are in some ways unaware of the vast career possibilities to be explored in our national games and sports.

16. Going Digital

The College is highly committed to adopt digital practices in all office and students related work. During the current Covid-19 pandemic also, the College has seamlessly switched over to the digital mode in academic and administrative functioning. Teachers and students are provided all facilities and administrative assistance in the conduct of online teaching-learning. IQAC collaborates with various departments to organize virtual lectures and talks and interviews of eminent personalities across the world. The College also encourages the faculty to record lectures through screencast-o-matic v2.0 software for future reference and benefit of the students.

The Administration took the digitalization one step further by transfiguring the students' I-cards into Single Sign-on (SSO) card. This card bearing bar-code is an in-house product developed by the technical team of the college. This one stop card is revolutionary as it makes the entire data just one click away and so is less time consuming with minimum chances of being faulty and ensures better access to the on-campus facilities like:

- Issuing books in library - the students can issue books with the help of SSO card and they would not require any separate library card.
- Security - It makes screening easier on special days like student elections, College fest, annual function etc. to avoid any scuffles and untoward incidents in the campus.
- Payment of bills - the College is also thinking of creating a pay wallet which will be connected with students' account so as to make their campus experience better.
- The Administration is virtually in touch with the non-teaching staff all the time during office hours. All the officials of the College are connected with the Principal through Google worksheet where routine jobs are assigned to concerned officials and are routinely monitored.
- The College teaching staff is always updated with real-time LED display in the staffroom which is used for the display of time-table and other important notices.

17. Inclusive Education and Development

The practice of Inclusive Education and Development continues from the last year as it serves meaningful benefit for the students. Since the location of the College is very strategic, the students from NCR/East Delhi get the maximum benefit of studying in a premier Delhi University college. The College gives value-based education to the students (as is the vision of the College) and also takes care of the professionalism of the Industry/market and prepares the students for the competitive world outside. Remedial classes, workshops organized by different departments, Placement Cell and Skill Development Cell, industry interaction through CIISD give the students enough exposure and feel of the professional world.

18. Community Outreach Programme

SLC is actively sensitive to its Institutional Social Responsibility and promotes institution- neighbourhood - community initiatives and outreach programs through its various activities that broadly fall under NCC/NSS/WDC/EOC/ Sports. SLC is surrounded by many underdeveloped, overpopulated and minority community localities, and so becomes the sole facilitator, in the area, of achieving academic excellence for students belonging to economically backward classes and minority communities.

- The College is located in an area of the city densely populated by under-privileged sections of society. SLC's policy of giving preference to the girl students in the Admissions is largely aimed at correcting the gender bias/disparity in the neighbourhood and community.
- SLC is the foremost College in East Delhi Campus of the University of Delhi with outstanding Sports facilities. The College promotes sports and games in the trans-Yamuna region of Delhi by providing opportunities and best coaching facilities to the young and talented players from low-income groups or underprivileged sections of society.
- SLC has also adopted Shahdara mandi and has conducted cleanliness drives, switch over to cashless trading and plastic free campaigns.
- SLC has adopted 5 villages under UBA project under MoE, GOI. The team has conducted extensive surveys of the said villages, participated in the Swachata hi Sewa campaign, interacted with villagers and other stakeholders of the villages. The team has also worked with and helped the adopted villages during COVID-19 pandemic in following ways: poster and video distribution about maintaining hygiene and sanitation, distribution of food packets, distribution of rashan, distribution of masks, dissemination of information through Whatsapp groups to farmers regarding precautions to be taken in farming activities during the pandemic etc.
- The College has tie-ups with several NGOs to work for the community. NSS volunteers of the College visit slum areas and spread awareness about cleanliness in collaboration with NGOs
- The tree plantation activities organized by the College are aimed at improving the air quality in and around the College, as well as for creating awareness about protection of environment.
- WDC regularly organises activities to sensitize the students and staff to gender related issues and to promote respect for human beings irrespective of race, religion, colour or gender.
- Most of the activities of the Equal Opportunities Cell such as remedial classes and Spoken English classes for students from under-privileged communities and facilities for differently abled also largely benefit the students from surrounding areas.

- The College participates in all national initiatives aimed at promoting good citizenship such as cleanliness drive, skill and entrepreneurship development initiatives, “Make in India” campaign, etc. The College has set up Centre for Skill Development following the launch of this programme by the Union Government.
- Under the aegis of WDC and ICC, the College regularly organizes workshops, lectures, sensitization programmes, counseling sessions, film screenings and live performances on gender issues and discrimination.
- The students at SLC are taught the importance of participating in community service and contributing to help the deprived and the underprivileged sections of society. The NSS wing of the College lives up to its motto “Love All and Serve All”. The students engaged with NSS volunteer with a number of NGOs. They also organize clothes donation drive to support NGOs like Amar Jyoti. The NSS, every year, organizes a blood donation camp in the College.
- NCC girls of SLC have participated and organized Self-defense Camp, Yoga Camp, Tree Plantation drive and save Yamuna Campaign’
- The College also provides fee concession, financial aid, book aid, awards and prizes to students from underprivileged sections of society.
- The College has NCC, NSS, Women Development Center, Centre for Holistic Development, Centre for Industry Interaction and Skill Development, Ambedkar Study Circle, Gandhi Study Circle etc. which organize events dedicated towards community service like blood donation camp, tree plantation drive, Save Yamuna Campaign, gender sensitization, identity discourses, moral education etc. to enhance the sense of community feeling and citizenship among the students.
- The NSS of the College also regularly organizes “Nirbheek” – One week Women self-defense camp for girl students.
- The UBA team and NSS team of the College has already conducted cleanliness drives in Yamuna Bazaar Ghat no 21. The Development and Maintenance of Ghat No.-21 has been done along with repairing, beautification, restructuring, painting and colouring work.
- The Enactus team of the College has worked on community outreach projects like “PRAYOJYA” (2018). The project is an effort to reduce plastic pollutants in our surrounding by transforming them from waste plastic bottles to useful and decorative plastic utensils and simultaneously providing employment to women from underprivileged communities and train them in the art of making different kinds of decorative stuff with plastic.

19. Institutional Social Responsibility Initiatives during Covid-19 Pandemic

The College has also undertaken several institutional social responsibility initiatives during Covid-19 Pandemic. Some of the details are as follow:

- The College actively supports and observes government advisories issued about preventive measures, for Covid-19 pandemic, like hand hygiene, social distancing, cough etiquette are circulated among the staff, students, surrounding neighbourhood and in adopted villages from time to time.
- A WhatsApp group with members from the adopted villages, under UBA, like the Pradhans, village elders and officials has been formed so as to spread awareness about hygiene and sanitation among as many house holds as possible.
- The students of the college have been making handmade soap and masks to distribute them in their neighbourhood so as to help people maintain good hygiene and fight Covid-19 pandemic.
- NSS volunteers have also taken care of abandoned pets and stray animals; they feed them on every day basis in their neighbourhoods.
- The College is actively involved in food distribution among the poor and the homeless. NSS students of the college also regularly distribute ration to the needy people in slum areas.
- Student members also make handmade masks and distribute them to vegetable vendors, slum dwellers and many others in their neighbourhood.
- The UBA team and NSS team of the College conducts cleanliness drives in Yamuna Bazaar Ghat no 21. The Development and Maintenance of Ghat No.-21 has been done along with repairing, beautification, restructuring, painting and colouring work.
- SLC students academically help the students in villages and slums through virtual modes.
- The Head of the institution regularly meets and interacts with students via virtual platform in order to resolve their queries regarding uncertainty of the academic session due to the pandemic situation.
- Counselling Cell has been activated with Mobile no. of professional counsellor and doctor to address students' anxiety and other issues.
- The college also regularly organizes counselling sessions for students through ICC, WDC and Placement Cell.
- The Principal follows the open door policy and is always available to students during office hours.

- The college has a very active mentoring mechanism in which teacher mentors regularly meet their mentee students in order to resolve their academic and other concerns.
- During the Covid-19 pandemic, the college also facilitated the mobile data recharge of students' phones so that they do not miss out on interactions and classes with teachers.

20. Yamuna Festival

As a maiden attempt to pay homage to the life line of our city, the Yamuna river, Shyam Lal College, University of Delhi conducted the Yamuna Festival 2021 on 5th and 6th of March in College campus as well as Yamuna Ghat. The theme of the Festival was "Conservation and Rejuvenation of the Ever Green Yamuna". The festival was organized by the Fine Arts Society, NSS and Eco Club in collaboration with IQAC. A Plantation and Cleanliness drive, along with a Pledge to conserve the river was held at the Ghat of Yamuna followed by an Eco-friendly Arti. Both online and offline events like Nukkad Natak, Dance Performances, Stage Play, Musical Compositions and live Band, Debate, Film Making, Photography and Fine Arts Exhibition were organized as a part of Festival.

Infrastructure

During the year under Report, the following infrastructure facilities are added:

- College has undertaken major infrastructural upgradation with ongoing construction of 2nd Floor in the Old building with several new classrooms, multipurpose Hall, Computer Labs.
- College is also constructing an STP plant.
- Green grass carpeting work was done in College grounds.
- The committee room has been developed in the Porta Block
- Repair renovation has been done in the College Office for smooth conduct of administrative tasks.

University Examination Results and Scholarship

Due to untiring efforts of our motivated faculties, the students of SLC have shown wonderful results as proved by the mean pass percentage of 99.05%. A big congratulation to all the students and faculty.

Once again this year, our students have performed exceptionally well, and 96.09% percentage of students qualified with first divisions in the examinations. The percentage of students passing with First Division has been gradually been increasing over the years.

I extend my heartiest congratulations to all the students for their creditable performance in the University Examinations and for keeping the banner of SLC flying high on the academic front.

Training & Placement Cell

The Cell provides various opportunities of Placement and Internship at notable organizations like 360 Degree Cloud Pvt. Centre for Skill Development (CSD)

Centre for Skill Development organized several activities along with managing Add-on courses in college. Events organized during academic session 2020-21:

- Foreign Language Courses: The session started with Third Edition of Add-on Courses in college for students to ace the competition in globalized world. This year also the Centre received an overwhelming response to its Add-on courses successfully running since 2018. Certificate courses in four foreign languages(German, Spanish, French and Japanese)were organized in academic session 2020-21. Other than this, Diploma course in Spanish language was also conducted. Overall 120 students joined various language courses this year. The Foreign Language Courses are conducted under the aegis of Department of Germanic and Romance Studies, University of Delhi and the Department of East Asian Studies, University of Delhi.
- Mastering the Stock Market Course: The Centre for Skill Development conducted its popular Certificate Course in Mastering the Stock Market collaboration with BSE Institute Ltd. from 15th September 2020 to 31st October 2020. The course provided detailed knowledge of stock market and its mechanisms along with practical knowledge of stock trading to the students. A batch of 34 students was trained in current academic session.
- On 27th August, 2020 CSD organized a national webinar on the theme “Professional Success: Perspectives and Suggestions” for students to learn about important components of higher employability. Mr. Pulock Bhattacharji, Vice President, BSE Inst. Ltd. shared his knowledge and expertise with the audience.
- First International LIS (Learn, Innovate and Start-up) Summit was organized jointly with IQAC, CSD and E-Cell of the college in collaboration with XAMK Finland on 3-4 Sept, 2020. The two day Summit had scholarly deliberations from scholars, academicians & Entrepreneurs across the world along with student centric innovative competitions Micro Content League and E-Hackathon.
- On 28th January, 2021 the Centre in collaboration with Beacon IAS organized an interactive session on ‘How to crack Civil Services’. The session was enriched by the speaker Mr. Rahul Agrawal (DANICS 2012) who focused on the importance of discipline, diligence, right guidance, consistency for the preparation of the exam. He also explained how Civil Service is different from any other profession and about when to commence the preparation for it. The webinar was interactive with around 250 participants attending it.

- A Webinar on Careers and Opportunities in Artificial Intelligence with the sole purpose of providing much useful information on ‘Artificial Intelligence and Augmented Reality’ was held on April 5, 2021. Speaker Dr. Jyoti Ahluwalia, Associate Professor in Artificial Intelligence and Machine learning at Sushant University, discussed tremendous opportunities in this upcoming sector.
- An internship drive was carried out in collaboration with Internshala throughout the session 2020-21, where students got to know about the internship opportunities related to their field in reputed organizations. Many students got associated with these companies offering paid internships as well as placements. Internship proposals were provided in April, 21 in prestigious Martin Mulligan Marketing Ltd., United Kingdom for Digital Marketing, HR, Sales, Financial Analyst, Market Research and Marketing internships. All internships were available immediately and remotely. Interested students have enrolled and are enriching their experience.

The Centre also provided internship opportunities with FounderINDIA for Content Writing positions starting from June, 21. This received an overwhelming response as it was a 3-month paid internship where students could turn themselves into professionals.

Centre for Holistic Development (CHD)

The College, in its efforts to maximum the teaching learning outcome, has not stopped engaging its students and faculty members even during the pandemic and nation-wide lockdown. Centre for Holistic Development has successfully organized many virtual competitions and Webinars even during the times when the world has been brought to standstill. It has organized following events during the academic year 2020-2021:

- National Online Yoga Competition and Lecture on Yoga and Vedanta: May 18, 2020 CHD in collaboration with IQAC has successfully organised its first National level Online Yoga Competition on 18th May 2020. Gandhi Study Circle (GSC)

National webinar on Relevance of Gandhian Thoughts and Ethics During the Covid Pandemic and After on 2nd of October 2020, in collaboration with IQAC, with Swami Shyama Chaitanya ji, Expert on Gandhi and Vedas, Rishikesh and Dr. Devasia M. Anthony, Assistant Professor, Department of Philosophy, Hindu College, University of Delhi as resource persons. The first speaker, Swami Shyama Chaitanya, is a Gandhian and studies Indian Vedas- spoke extensively on spirituality and explained how Gandhi used our Vedic knowledge in his own life and philosophy. He explained the key to overcome the current pandemic times is through Yogic Gyana, which teaches us, how to discipline our body and mind. The second speaker Dr. Anthony M. Devasia, touched the ethical aspect of Gandhian Philosophy and explained the relationship between Achara and Vichara. The lecture was followed by a brief discussion between the resource person and participants and ended with a vote of thanks.

Eco Club and Innovation Club

- The Club organized the Kite flying Awareness drive from 14.01.2021-16.02.2021. Kite flying is one of the famous sport in India among children and students and it catches pace during the festival season like Makar Sankranti, Republic Day and Basant Panchmi. However, kite flying by using thread made out of plastic, nylon or similar such synthetic material including popularly known "Chinese thread/ manja" or any other thread coated with glass/ metallic components causes a lot of injury to human beings and birds which many a times turns out to be fatal. Therefore, in order to prevent adverse effects on human beings, birds, environment and electrical assets, etc. Eco club volunteers went all out to save its fathered friends and took initiative to conduct 4 week awareness drive.

- The Club also celebrated Yamuna Mahotsav from 5th to 6th of March, 2021 in which more than 60 Eco club volunteers participated. It was the first Yamuna Mahotsav to create awareness for protecting conservation of Yamuna River. Eco club of SLC along with NSS unit also undertook the Plantation drive, Cleanliness drive, Yamuna Aarti with Eco friendly deyas made by team along with more than 1000 lamps at Ghat No. 21, Yamuna Bazar, Kashmiri Gate, Delhi 6. Ecoclub volunteers also organized Art and craft exhibition where handmade nests, flowerpots, environmentally friendly bags, wall hangings etc. were displayed.
- The Club also organized Awareness campaign towards the Disposal and usage of sanitary pads from 3-01-2021 to 9-01-2021 with more than 40 students. - Kalakar: It was a mono act competition.
- Meme-O-Mania: It was a meme making competition.
- Art from Heart: It was an art battle, this contest had three categories i.e. Painting, Sketching and Doodling.
- Grapica: It was a digital book cover designing competition

➤ Short Film Making Contest

Falcon Films, organized Short Film Making Contest held under Yamuna Festival on 5-6th March 2021. The event was conducted in online mode as well as offline mode. We received many entries from all across the country and the talent pool was astounding. It was the originality of ideas, uniqueness of thought, captivating screenplay, realistic acting, skilful direction and outstanding cinematography that set the winning entry apart from others.

JHAROKHA (The Dramatics Society)

The society conducted its online auditions on 8th of December 2020 for the students, it was a three-round process. The audition was successful enough to attract as many as 140+ registrations. Out of these 35 members were selected.

Production of the session: Yamuna (an original play performed & produced by Jharokha)

The idea behind this play was to bring forth the exploitation of the river by the humankind and their unquenchable thirsts and demands.

- Jharokha organized a production-based Theatre Workshop for the society members for a duration of 10 days. The workshop was a successful collaborative project with SOCH Rangmanch, a Delhi based theatre group. The project worked on preparing and enhancing the annual production 'Yamuna' a play written by the team members. The directors invited for the workshop were Mr. Rajiv Kohli, founder and director of SOCH Rangmanch and Mr. Siddharth Saxena, assistant director of SOCH Rangmanch. Both online and offline sessions were conducted to make the play a success. The society also took part in a theatre workshop organized by IIT Goa as one of the lined-up events of their Annual Cultural Fest 'CultRang'. The speaker of the workshop was Mr. Pradeep Bajpayee, a seasoned actor and director. He provided the members with valuable insights of the theatre world.

QASIDA: The Poetry Society of SLC

- AUDITIONS AND ORIENTATIONS 2020-21: The Society began the auditions for the session 2020-21 on 17th January. 22 students were shortlisted based on the poetic works submitted by them for the second round of audition. The Society conducted an orientation programme for the new members of the society on 31st January. The Society organizes weekly poetry sessions throughout the academic year.
- Yamuna Festival SLC 2021: Open Mic Poetry Competition : As part of the Yamuna Festival, Qasida organized a Virtual Open Mic Poetry Competition on the 6th Of March, 2021. The theme of the competition was Environment/ River/ Water Conservation. We received a total registration of more than 60 students from all the colleges of University of Delhi and Noida.
- Competitions And Collaborations : Qasida has collaborated with Your Campus Guide as Official Community Partner in organising a Pan India Virtual Talent Quest conducted during the 20th of May till the 10th of June with more than a thousand participants from all over India. The quest was conducted in total seven categories. Moreover, in the Creative Writing Category both the two winners are from our own society. Our own member, Nibedita Rajkumari (BA Prog. 2nd year) was judged as the best writer in English in the Creative Writing Category and another one Mansi Sah (B.Com Hons. 1st Year) was judged as the best writer in Hindi.

SWARAAGAM: The Music Society

Swaraagam performed a theme-based musical concert on the occasion of Yamuna Festival, 6th March 2021. The society initiated the event by bringing up its own version of a tribute to the rivers of the world by recalling one's duty to join hands in a drive to conserve the rivers.

Internal Complaints Committee

The Internal Complaints Committee organized a training session for students on 9.6.2021 in Collaboration with the Breakthrough Trust. It aimed to create awareness among students about harassment in public spaces and how to handle the same. Ms. Shilpy Singh and Mr. Farman Ahmad from the Trust engaged the audience in an interactive session, followed by questions and comments from students who were encouraged to share their experiences.

Garden Committee

- Garden committee of our college organised “Umang-East Delhi flower show 3.0” on March 1, 2021 in its campus to encourage the spirit of Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat & Swachha Bhart Abhiyan in collaboration with Eco club and the Special attraction was Opportunity for Nurseries, handmade art and craft. The Flower Show was inaugurated by the Chief Guest; Hon’ble Vice Chancellor Prof. P.C. Joshi. He addressed the gathering along with Smt. Savita Gupta, Chairperson,

SLC Governing body and Prof. Balram Pani, Dean of colleges D.U. Our students not only participated in flower show but also exhibited some craft work made out of waste. They made some creative and useful things from the waste. They even made some different kind of Bird nest from the waste material.

- Plantation drive was conducted on March 1, 2021 on the occasion of Flower show 3.0. Hon'ble Vice Chancellor Prof. P.C. Joshi along with various dignitaries and esteemed Facilities participated in a tree plantation drive. Various saplings and palm trees were planted on that occasion. Garden committee also organised Eco friendly Rangoli competition in collaboration with Eco club in the same event.
- Garden committee also participated in University 63rd Annual Flower Show held on 5th March 2021 at the Mughal Garden (in front of Vice-Chancellor's Office) University of Delhi and bagged 3 prizes in Categories C. Third prize in category C section 4, 7 and 1 and one prize which are highly recommended. For the first time our college also participated in college Garden categories and bagged 8 prizes which are highly recommended. Apart from this our college also bagged 2nd prize for the virtual videography competition. Our Mali Mahender Singh also won Best Mali Ward.

- Hanging baskets were also bought for the beautification of garden
- Large cemented pots were bought

Debating Society: SHEERSHASTH

- On 12th September 2020, Sheershasth : The Debating Society Of SLC with IQAC organized "EXTEMPORANEOUS' 2020- AN ONLINE BILINGUAL EXTEMPORE COMPETITION" to commemorate Swami Vivekananda's Chicago speech at its 125th anniversary. The event was organized virtually to provide the students an online platform to express their thoughts on various social issues prevailing currently in our surroundings. All the participants were given different topics which covered up all the current social, economical, and political issues prevailing in the society and how can these be eliminated by implying teachings of Swami Vivekananda Ji.

- Sheershashth, The Debating Society of SLC, organized its Annual Bilingual Inter College Conventional Debate Competition Orator's bout '21 on 6th of March ,2021 in online mode via google meet under First edition of Yamuna festival. The motion of debate was “THBT activism on river conservation died down because of prosperity from industrialization.” All the participants were awarded with participation certificates and winners with prizes.

College Initiatives in Covid-19 Pandemic Situation

Status of online teaching-learning undertaken by the College:

The faculty members at SLC are dedicated to their work and are actively engaged in providing necessary support to the students in the Covid-19 pandemic times and the subsequent lockdown. The college faculty members are using following ways and platforms to engage with students towards continuing teaching-learning process:

- Uploading e-resources on college website for student access.
- The students access the e-resources uploaded by their teachers.
- Engagement of student classes through online platforms like Google Meet and Google Classroom. Teachers engage the students throughout via Zoom, Webex, Skype etc. for innovative, deliberations, competitions and meaningful mentoring.
- The online class sessions are recorded and sent to students who are unable to join the same.
- The faculty members also use Google classrooms to upload PDF files and videos and solve student queries using Chatroom options.
- Teachers have used Google forms for taking tests, projects and assignments.
- The College has made available online reading material to all the students through N-list portal for which all students have been given login and password.
- The College has also provided link on the college website for the reading material made available by the Delhi University library system and SOL.
- The incumbent holds weekly meetings with the TICs via virtual platforms during the Covid-19 for monitoring the smooth functioning of the teaching-learning process and other academic and administrative matters.
- The College also started a helpline for students to help in data recharge of the mobile phones of those students who could not afford data recharge and were, thus, unable to attend online classes and complete assignments.
- The college has also organized series of Webinars and online discussions on various topics of contemporary relevance.

Apart from academic initiatives, the College has also undertaken several institutional social responsibility initiatives during Covid-19 Pandemic. Some of the details are as follow:

- The College actively supported and observed our Hon'ble Prime Minister's nationwide call for social distancing and subsequent country wide lockdown. Accordingly, government advisories issued about preventive measures like hand hygiene, social distancing, cough etiquette are circulated among the staff, students, surrounding neighbourhood and in adopted villages from time to time.
- A WhatsApp group with members from the adopted villages, under UBA, like the Pradhans, village elders and officials was formed so as to spread awareness about hygiene and sanitation among as many households as possible.
- Distribution of masks
- The students of the college have been making handmade soap and masks to distribute them in their neighbourhood so as to help people maintain good hygiene and fight this chronic disease.
- NSS volunteers have also taken care of abandoned pets and stray animals; they feed them on everyday basis in their neighbourhoods.
- The College is actively involved in food distribution among the poor and the homeless. NSS students of the college are also regularly distributing ration to the needy people in slum areas.
- Student members also make handmade masks and distribute them to vegetable vendors, slum dwellers and many others in their neighbourhood.
- The UBA team and NSS team of the College has already conducted cleanliness drives in Yamuna Bazaar Ghat no 21. The Development and Maintenance of Ghat No.-21 has been done along with repairing, beautification, restructuring, painting and colouring work.
- SLC students academically help the students in villages and slums through virtual modes.

Initiatives towards keeping mental well-being of staff and students are as follow :

- SLC has initiated Project *Anutosh* under which we are committed, through a structured institutional mechanism, to help rebuild the lives of those students who have been worst affected by the Covid-19 and have lost their parent/s and are looking at a grim and uncertain future. The Project team planned a structured and long term fostering of these kids with full support from the College administration. We initiated crisis response measures and efforts to address the immediate and long-term challenges faced by such students. The team identified 14 such students in the college who were in need of immediate mentoring, counselling and help. The team is mentoring them towards a safe and professionally secure future and also helping them in academic and other

- needs. The team is also helping to avail government schemes announced for such children who have lost their parent/s to Covid-19.
- The incumbent regularly meets and interacts with students via virtual platform in order to resolve their queries regarding uncertainty of the academic session due to the pandemic situation.
 - Counselling Cell has been activated with Mobile No of professional counsellor, doctor to address students' anxiety and other issues.
 - The college also regularly organizes counselling sessions for students through ICC, WDC and Placement Cell.
 - Principal is always available to students during office hours.
 - The college has a very active mentoring mechanism in which teacher mentors regularly meets their mentee students in order to resolve their academic and other concerns.
 - During the Covid-19 pandemic, the college also facilitated the mobile data recharge of students' phones so that they do not miss out on interactions and classes with teachers.

In the end I would like to thank all members of the Governing Body, my colleagues from both teaching and nonteaching staff who have extended their hand of cooperation and total support in managing the affairs of the institution. I also wish to place on record my sincere appreciation for the all-round cooperation and devoted support of members of staff of the College including Bursar Dr. Ashu Gupta, IQAC Coordinator Dr. Kusha Tiwari, Secretary Staff Council Sh.
