The Eco Club of Shyam Lal College organized a model competition on the theme "Rainwater Harvesting" to impart social awareness about water conservation due to climatic patterns. In the context of the water resources sector, this crisis is even more severe. Due to the limited availability of surface water resources, the overexploitation of groundwater resources has stressed the aquifers. The present situation requires public awareness about the importance of responsible water usage and implementing a Rainwater Harvesting system at all possible location. So, in this context, a Rainwater Harvesting model competition was organized from March 15th to 17th, 2023, in collaboration with the Swachh Action Plan (SAP). The students responded enthusiastically and came up with ideas for models depicting the different ways of conservation. This competition focused on the following ideas: The principles of reducing waste, reusing, and recycling resources and products are often called the "3 R's." Almost 50 students participated in this model competition.
