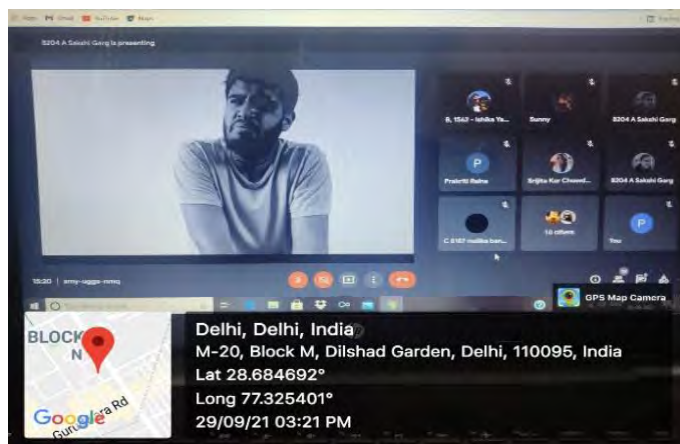
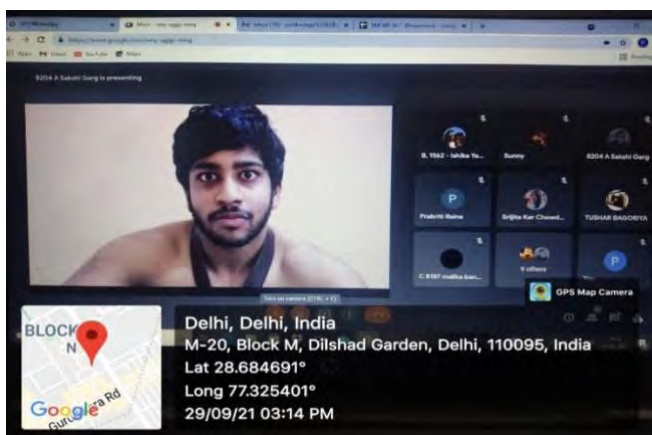

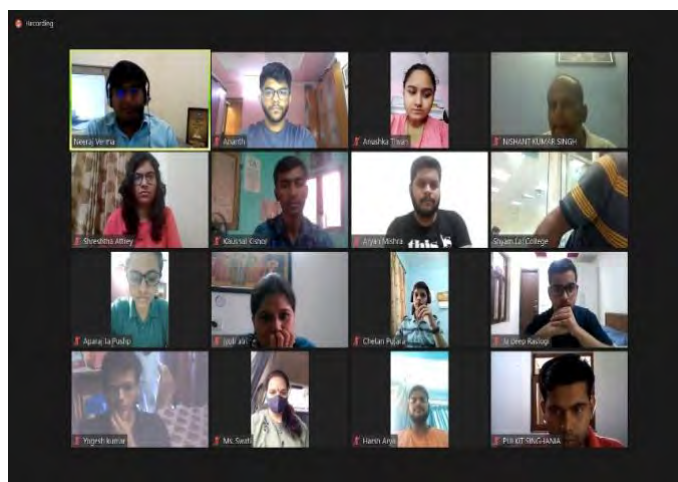

MIC DROP- AN OPEN MIC COMPETITION

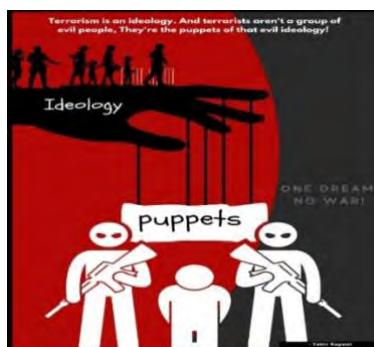
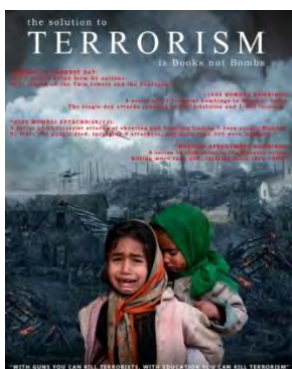

PEACE & BLISS :- HANDMADE POSTER MAKING COMPETITION (OFFLINE)

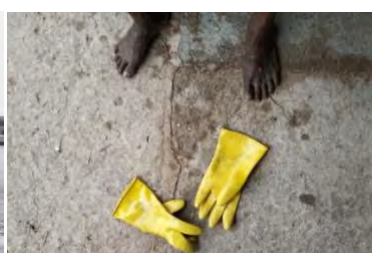

A MINUTE TO WIN- JAM COMPETITION (OFFLINE)

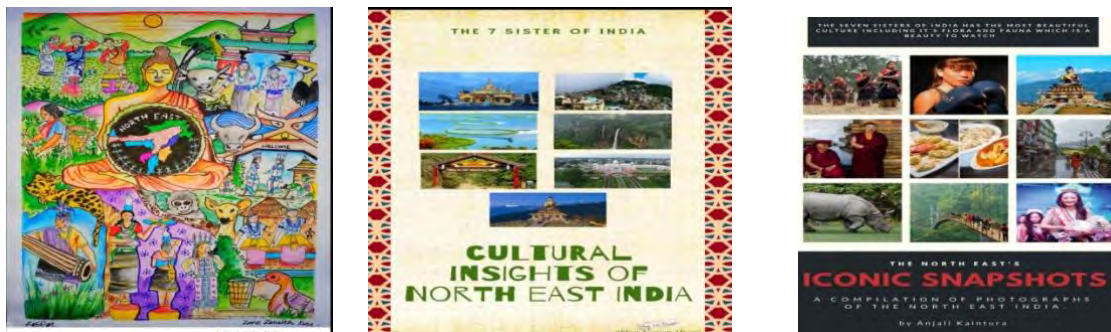
