

Call for Papers

The *National Conference on Bharatiya Bhasha Pariwar: संस्कृति से संवाद – Bharatiya Bhasha and Cultural Heritage* invites scholars, researchers, educators, and practitioners from across disciplines to contribute original research papers, conceptual essays, and case studies that explore the dynamic relationship between Indian languages (*Bharatiya Bhasha*) and the country's cultural, philosophical, and educational traditions.

This conference aims to foster dialogue between tradition and modernity by examining how Bharatiya languages act as both a vehicle and a repository of civilizational knowledge. It aligns with the vision of NEP 2020 to integrate *Bharatiya Gyana Parampara* (Indian Knowledge Systems) into mainstream academia, and to revitalize the relevance of Indian languages in higher education, research, and cultural life.
