

National Seminar on “One Nation One Election”

Brief Description:

Held on 19.03.2025 at MPH, Shyam Lal College

A national seminar on the topic 'One Nation, One Election' was organised in the Multi-Purpose Hall of Shyam Lal College (University of Delhi) on 19 March 2025. The centre of attraction of this event was its chief guest, in which the seminar was presided over by retired Justice Adarsh Kumar Goel, who has been the former Chairman of the National Green Tribunal and apart from being a judge in the Supreme Court, he has also been the Hon'ble Chief Justice of Orissa and Guwahati High Court. He explained how the articles are prescribed for amendment in the constitution, through which the process of amendment takes place as per the wish of the citizens. The keynote speaker of the seminar was Dr. Anirban Gangoli, who is the director of



Dr. Shyama Prasad Mookerjee Research Foundation, New Delhi. He said that till 1967, elections were held simultaneously in the Lok Sabha and Vidhan Sabha in the country, but due to some reasons, it is not so now. In this seminar, the Hon'ble Principal of the college, Prof. Rabi Narayan Kar has provided his dignified presence, through whom the seminar was completed. Dr. Kusha Tiwari, the director of IQAC of the college, was present, along with Prof. Neena Shirish. This program was organised by the Udgam Committee of the B.A. program, whose main coordinator was Assistant Professor Mr. Aakash Kumar Soni.
