Orientation programme on Anti- Ragging (1st August , 2025)

The Orientation programme on anti ragging was held on August 1, 2025, where our esteemed Principal Prof. Rabi Narayan Kar addressed the gathering. This orientation aimed to educate students about the college's anti-ragging policies and the resources available to support victims.



The Anti-Ragging Day (12th August 2025)

The Anti-Ragging Day, organised by the Anti-Ragging Committee of Shyam Lal College, University of Delhi, took place on August 12, 2025, at 11:30 AM in the Seminar Hall. The event aimed to raise awareness about the detrimental effects of ragging and promote a safe and supportive environment for students. The event was graced by the Chief Guest, Sh. Kanhaiya Lal Yadav, SHO of Shahdara, Prof. Rabi Narayan Kar, Principal, Shyam Lal College, distinguished speakers and attendees.

The event began with an introductory speech by Dr. Reeta Sharma, the Convener of the Anti-Ragging Committee. She welcomed the guests, faculty, and students and emphasised the importance of celebrating Anti Ragging Day to raise awareness about ragging and its negative impact on individuals and society. She emphasised the college's commitment to preventing ragging in all forms, thereby ensuring a safe learning environment for all students.



Prof. Rabi Narayan Kar, Principal, Shyam Lal College, expressed his strong disapproval of ragging and the severe consequences it has on the mental and emotional well-being of students. He stated that the college has a zero-tolerance policy towards ragging and that the administration is dedicated to ensuring a safe, inclusive, and welcoming environment for all

students. He also encouraged the students to be vigilant and report any cases of ragging promptly, assuring them of the college's full support.



Sh. Yadav narrated real-life stories of how ragging had led to tragic outcomes in many instances. He shared the story of a student from a nearby institution who had suffered immense trauma due to ragging, which led to the student's withdrawal from college and a long road to recovery. Sh. Yadav explained how the law had evolved to combat ragging and how the police had been actively involved in taking strict action against offenders.

He further emphasised the importance of students supporting one another and the need for a strong community to combat such harmful practices. His speech was impactful, leaving the audience with a sense of responsibility to contribute towards eradicating ragging and fostering a positive environment for learning and growth.



The session concluded with a vote of thanks to Shri Kanhaiya Lal Yadav Ji, Prof. Rabi Narayan Kar (Principal, Shyam Lal College), Dr. Reeta Sharma (Convener of the Anti-Ragging Committee), and all committee members, as well as the teaching and non-teaching staff of the college.

The essay writing competition (13th August 2025)

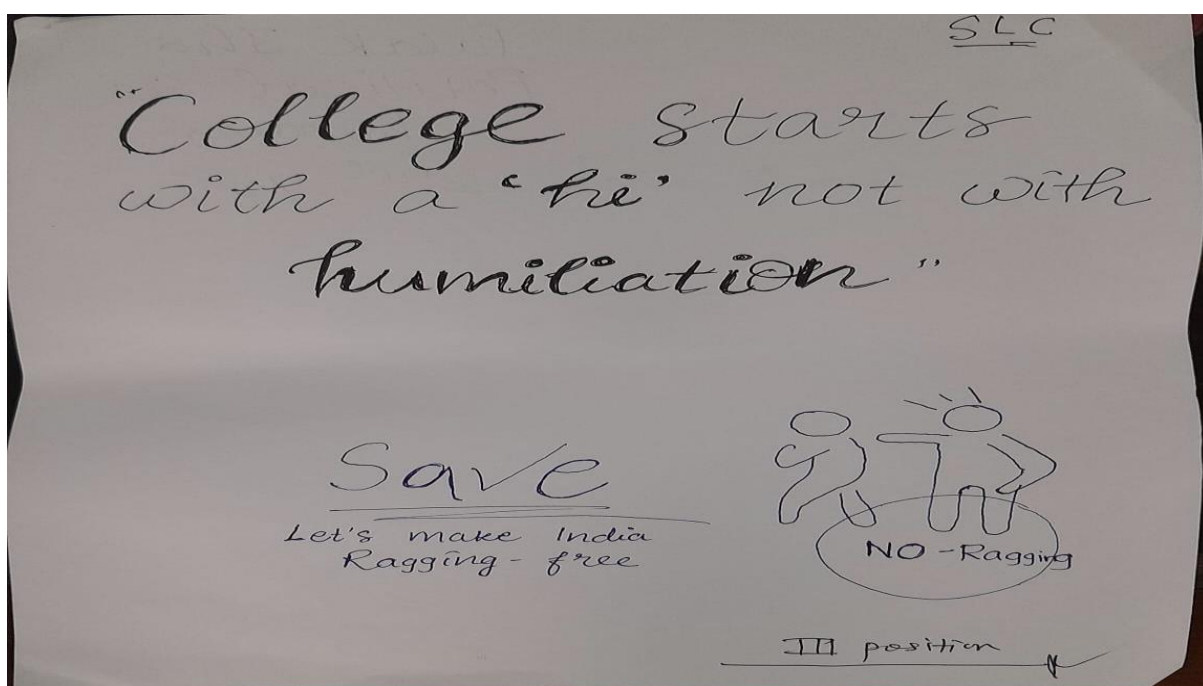
