Round 2: Held offline in the Seminar Hall, where selected finalists presented their solutions before a panel of judges. This round focused on the depth of analysis, creativity, feasibility of strategies, and clarity of presentation.

The event witnessed enthusiastic participation from students across diverse academic backgrounds, including commerce, economics, business, and management. The case scenarios posed were complex and reflective of real-life industry challenges, requiring students to apply critical thinking and propose sustainable, innovative solutions. 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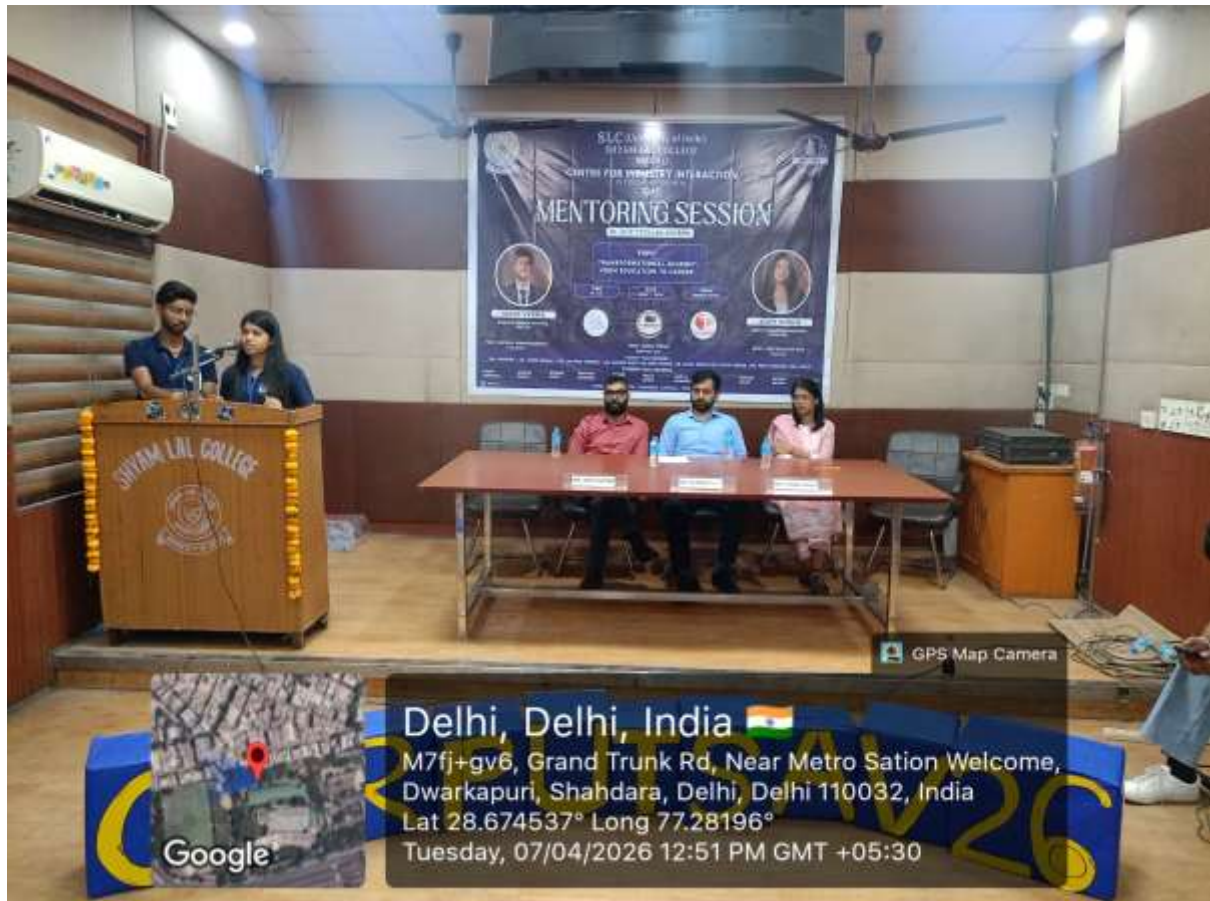
