The foreign language courses offered by the Centre are conducted under the aegis of the Department of East Asian Studies, University of Delhi. The classes for the Certificate Course in Japanese commenced on 9th October, 2024, providing students with a comprehensive curriculum designed to develop their linguistic abilities and cultural understanding.

Course Duration: 150 hours

Course Objectives:



- To understand and perform basic communication in limited daily situations using around 1000+ vocabulary and 150 sentence patterns.
- To understand the three scripts: Hiragana, Katakana and 240 Kanji characters.

Course Outcomes: Upon completion of the course, successful students:

- Can understand and perform communicative tasks in standard Japanese requiring simple and direct exchange of information on familiar and routine matters.
- Can compose sentences and personal responses to questions, employing sentence patterns and kanjis learnt at this level.
- Can read and write hiragana, katakana, around 240 kanjis and demonstrate comprehension of short texts.
