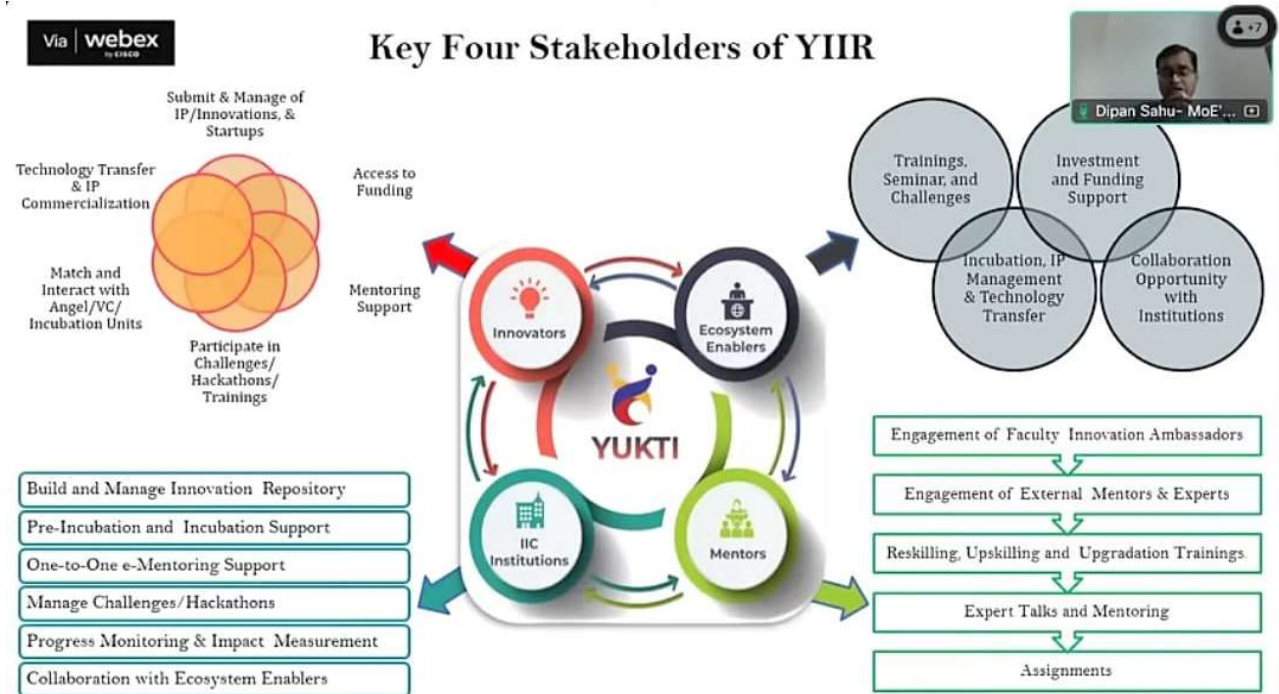

### Some of the Key moments of this Session:

The Session on "Creating and Managing YUKTI Innovation and IPR Repository (YIIR) in HEIs" outlines the registration process, benefits, and submission guidelines for the innovation repository in higher education institutions. Here are the key points:

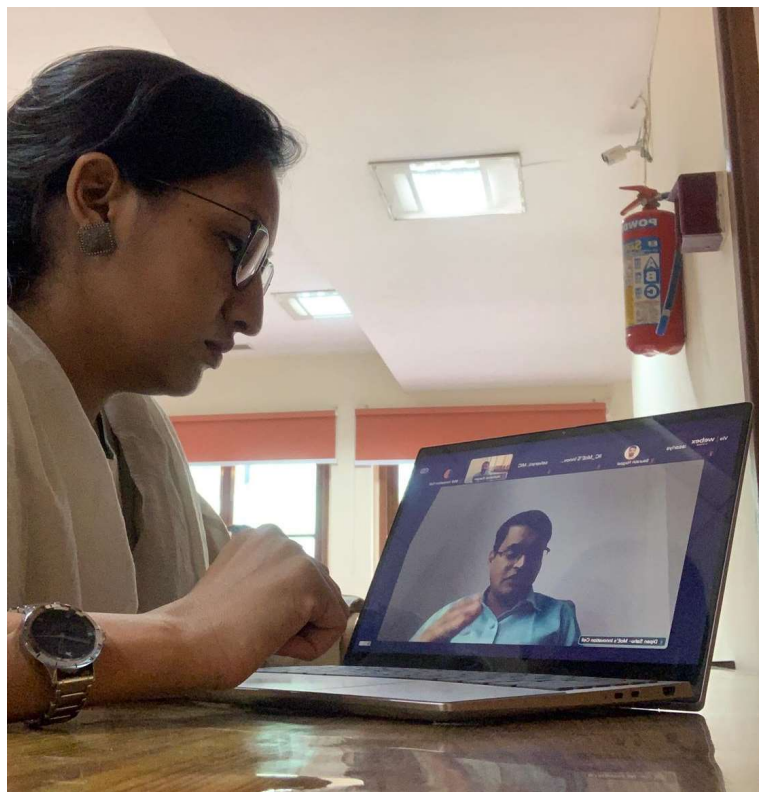
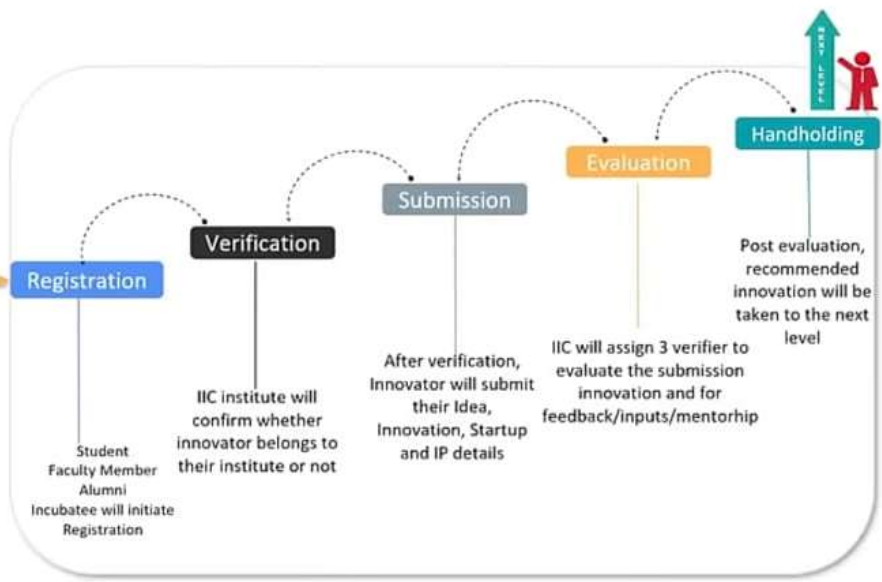
1. **Registration:** Students, faculty members, alumni, and incubates initiate registration on the YUKTI Innovation Repository (YIIR) platform. A responsible person from the institution ensures innovators are affiliated with the institution.
2. **Verification:** The Institute Innovation Council (IIC) verifies the innovator's affiliation, confirming they are part of the institute, whether as a student, faculty, alumni, or incubate.
3. **Submission:** After verification, innovators submit their ideas, innovations, startups, and IP details on the platform. There is no fixed deadline, but submissions received by August 31, 2024, will be included in the annual assessment.
4. **Evaluation:** The IIC assigns three verifiers to evaluate submissions. Verifiers provide feedback, inputs, and mentorship to help refine and enhance the innovations.
5. **Handholding:** Post-evaluation, recommended innovations receive further support and mentorship to progress to the next level, ensuring a pathway for development and potential commercialization.

These steps ensure a structured approach to foster innovation within institutions, providing a clear pathway from ideation to potential market entry.
