- **Facilitating collaboration:** By connecting with external stakeholders, IICs create opportunities for knowledge sharing, resource mobilization, and industry partnerships.

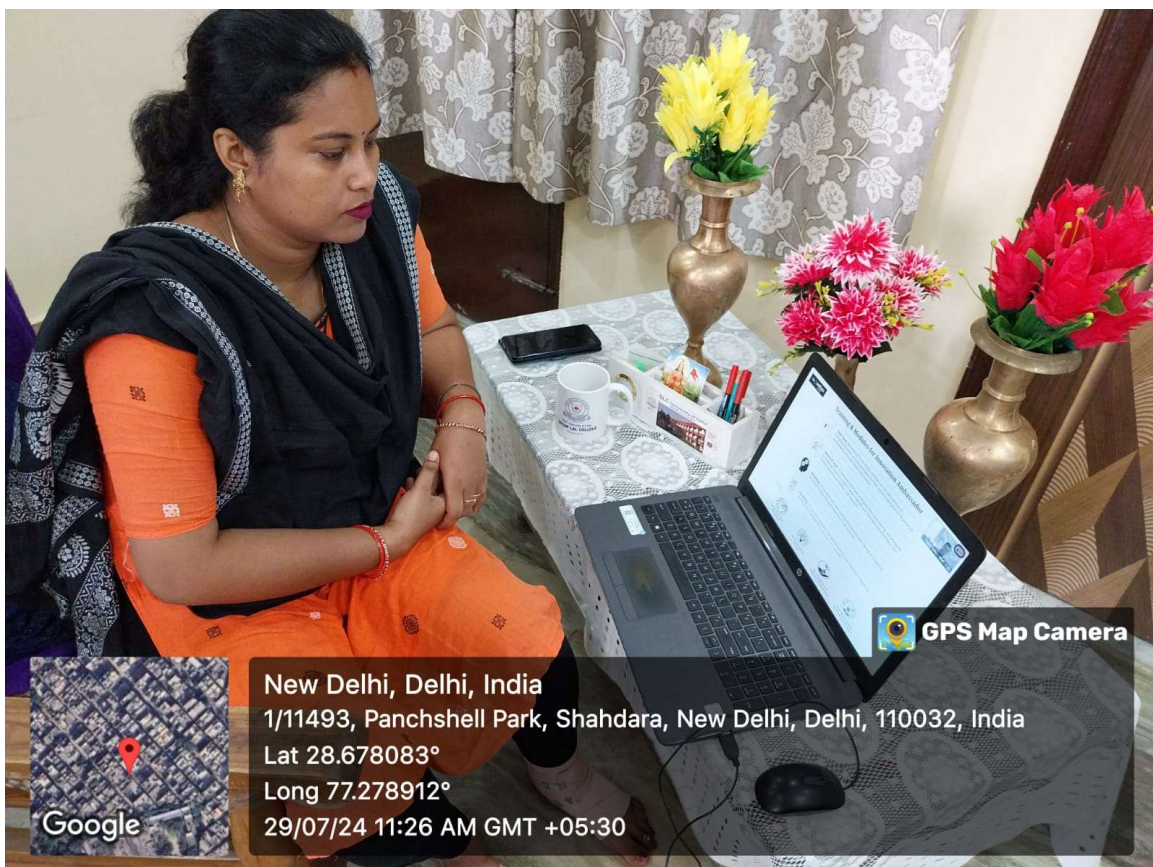
- **Supporting entrepreneurship:** IICs provide incubation and acceleration support to promising startups, helping them transform their ideas into successful ventures.
- **Measuring and recognizing achievements:** The star rating system and other performance indicators help IICs track progress and celebrate successes.

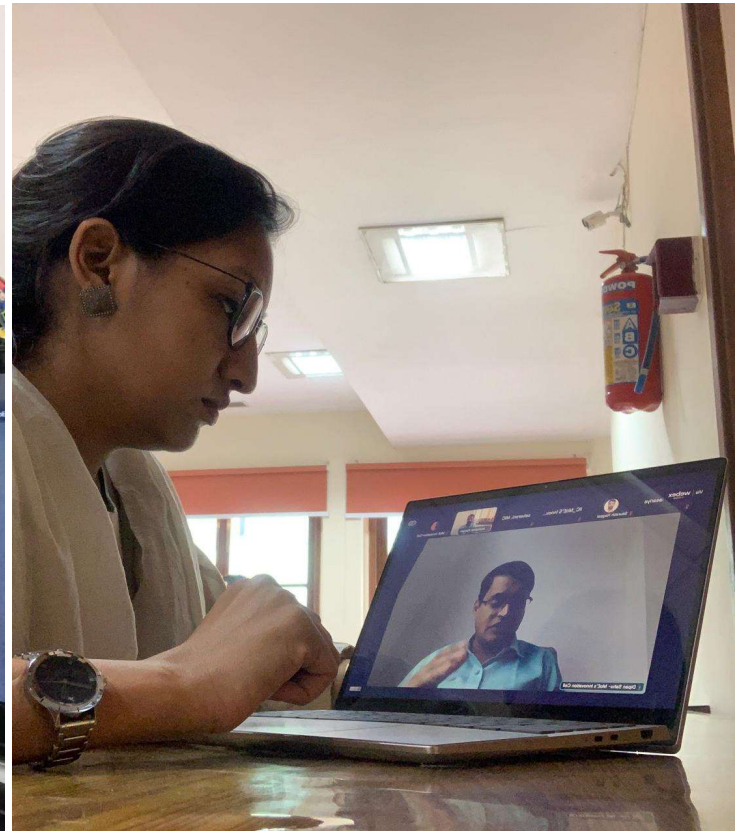
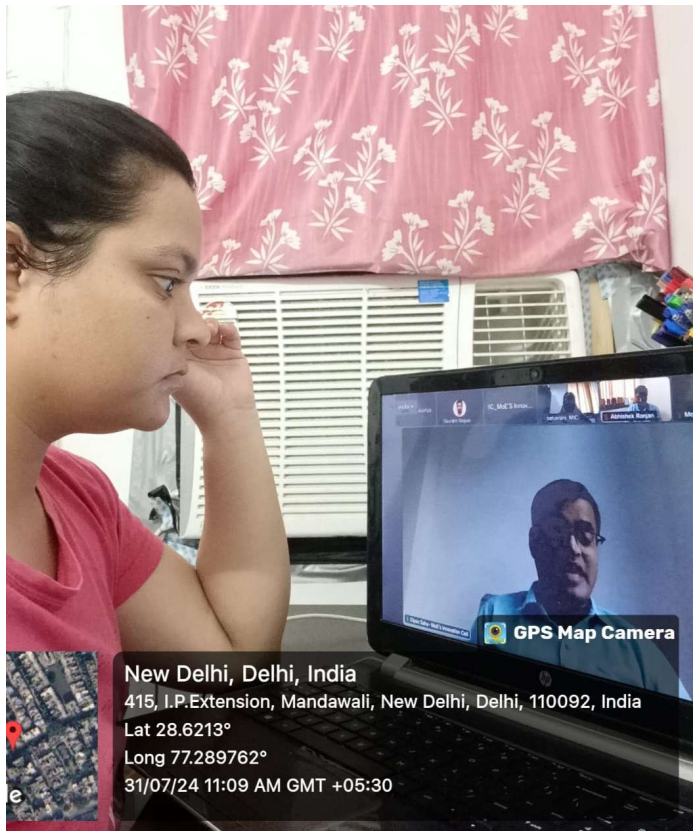
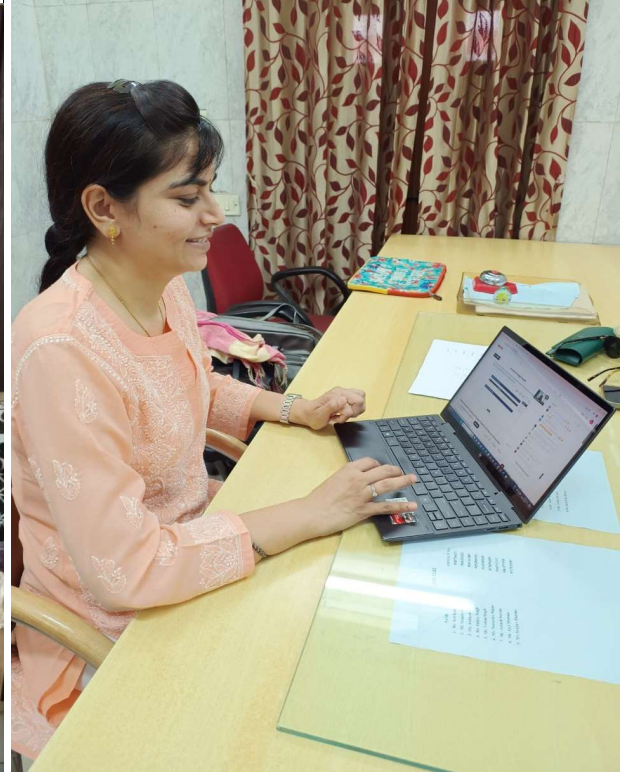
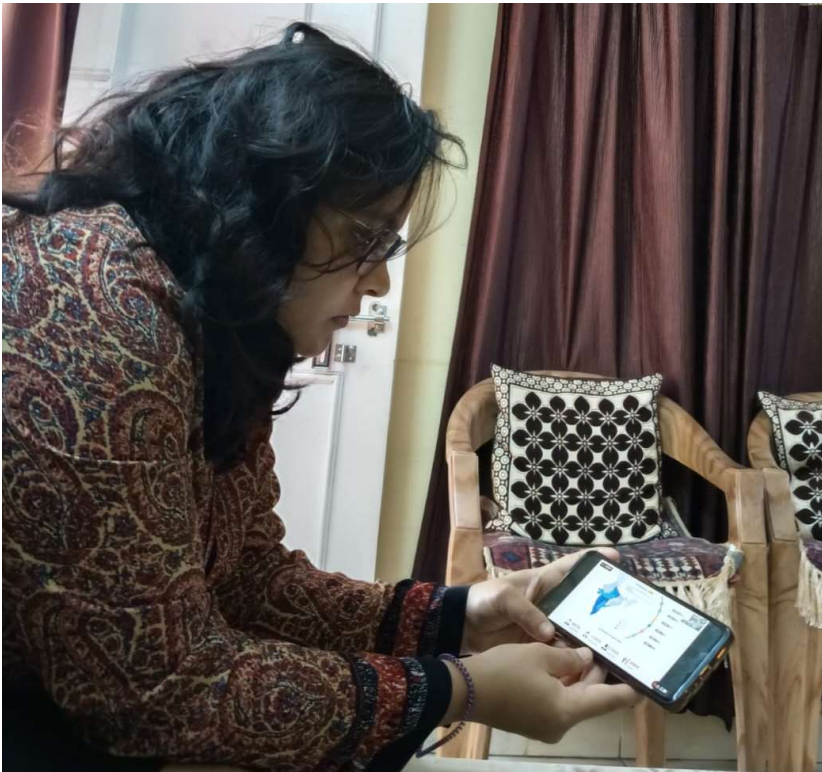
Recommendations

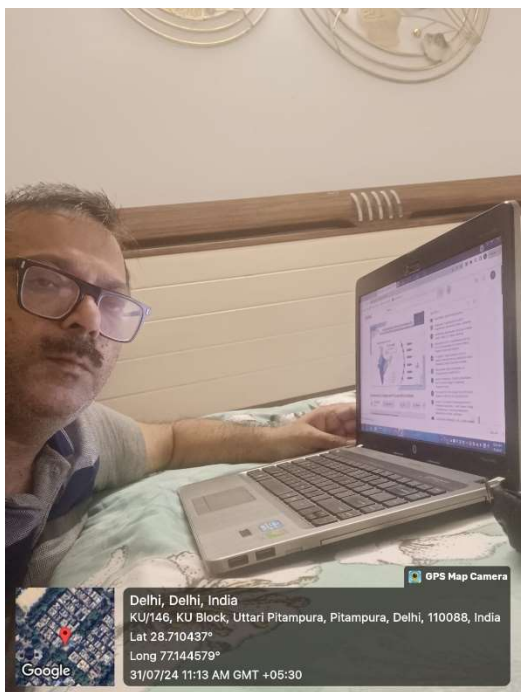

- Ad-hoc and Un-systematic Approach & Seasonal
- Isolation in Operation - Intra and inter - Institutional
- Lack of Awareness, & Existence of Information Dissymmetric among Students, Faculty Members, and Institution Authorities.
- Non-involvement and lack of Commitment of Top Authorities and Leaders
- Absence of Resource Sharing and Mobilization of Resources within and Outside the Institute
- Single Discipline- Multi-Disciplinary
- Redundancy & Duplicity in Efforts and Actions:
- Absence of Benchmarking & Standard Practices in HEIs to Drive Innovation and Startup Ecosystem in Campuses
- Absence of Non-Collaborative with Regional Ecosystem Enablers and Lack of Resource Mobilizing and Knowledge Sharing Mechanisms in HEIs.
- Lack of In-house Mentoring Capability and Institutional Capacity to Promote and Support Innovation and Entrepreneurship in HEIs
- Absence of Reward and Incentive for Participation
- Breaking Myths of Dependence on Grant-based Models and Innovation can only happen in Technical Institutions
