1. **Inspiring Students Through Success Stories:** The conference emphasized sharing 2-3 success stories with their respective alumni or current students, motivating this younger generation to explore innovation that can create impact.
2. **Empowering Students to Innovate:** Institutions need to inspire students to seek out real-world problem-solving as an exercise in fostering critical thinking, societal prosperity, and sustainable ways of living.
3. **India's Economic Future:** Highlighted the vital role of young innovators in driving India's growth, contributing toward the government's vision of a \$5 trillion economy by 2024, with a longer-term aim of reaching \$20 trillion.
4. **Innovation-Driven Education:** A call to foster a culture of innovation within institutions, encouraging creativity, experimentation, and fresh perspectives.
5. **Innovation Without Big Funding:** Emphasized that resourceful and impactful solutions can often be achieved without requiring massive funding, encouraging students to explore low-cost, effective methods.

### **Actionable Steps:**

- **Encourage Innovation from Day One:** Help students to start working in the sphere of innovation from their first year, plugged into reality, building up skill and confidence.
- **Leverage Innovation and Incubation Centers:** Connect students with a mentor, investor, and industry expert via incubation centers, creating an ecosystem to realize these ideas into workable solutions.
- **Transform Mindsets Towards Future-Oriented Thinking:** Foster a culture of promoting change, creativity, and collaboration, enabling students to challenge the norm and produce innovative projects.

These steps dictate how institutions will prompt innovation, give power to the students, and contribute to the economic growth of India.
