## 1. Event Overview

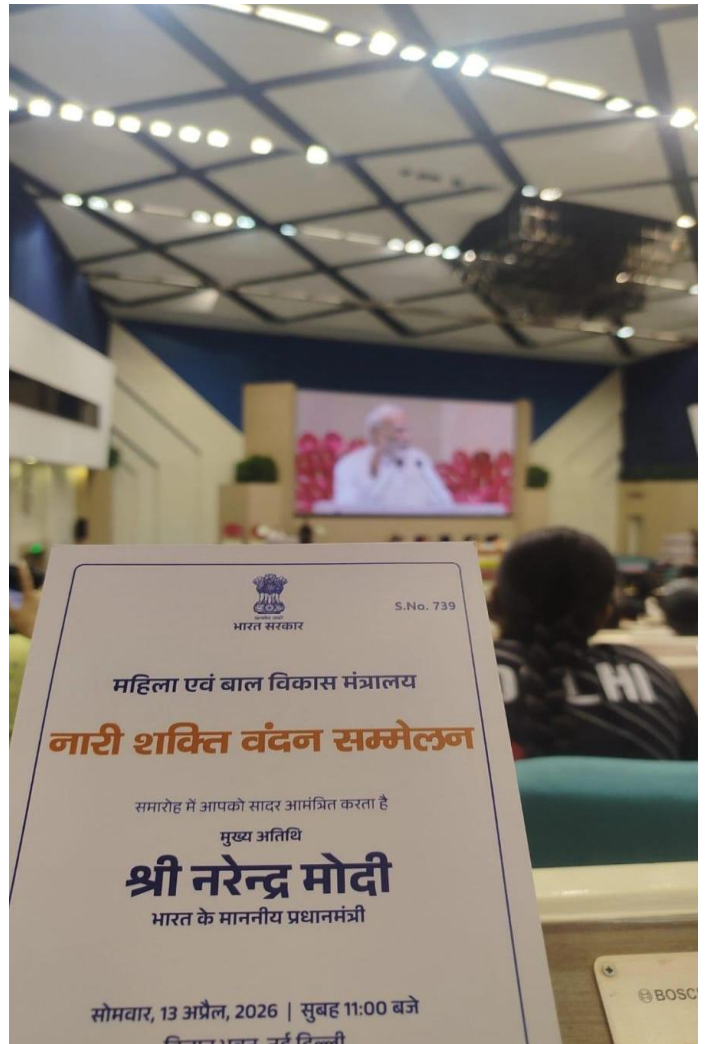


