### ABOUT JAMIA MILLIA ISLAMIA

Jamia Millia Islamia (Urdu: جامعه ملَيه السلاميه, abbreviated as JMI) is a central university located in New Delhi, India. Originally established at Aligarh, United Provinces (present-day Uttar Pradesh, India) during the British Empire in 1920, it moved to its current location in Okhla in 1935. It was given the deemed status by the University Grants Commission in 1962. On 26 December 1988, it became a central university. The university was founded by Mahmud Hasan Deobandi, Mohammad Ali Jauhar, Hakim Ajmal Khan, Mukhtar Ahmed Ansari, Abdul Majeed Khwaja, Allama Iqbal, Dr Zakir Hussain, Mahatma Gandhi and Maulana Abul Kalam Azad. Mahmud Hasan Deobandi, the leader of the Silk Letter Movement and the first student of Darul Uloom Deoband laid its foundation stone. Muhammad Ali Jauhar served as its first vicechancellor from 1920 to 1923, and Hakim Ajmal Khan was the first chancellor from 1920 to 1927.

In 2020, Jamia Millia Islamia was ranked 1st among all central universities in the country in rankings released by the Ministry of Education of India. In December 2021, the university received an 'A++' ranking by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council.
