FDP REPORT

A Faculty Development Programme on 'Indian Knowledge System: Revisiting Indian Literary and Cultural Traditions' was conducted by the Department of English, Shyam Lal College, in collaboration with Malviya Mission Teacher Training Centre, NIEPA from 24th - 29th June, 2024.

There were four sessions, of 1.5 hours each, everyday. There were 23 well renowned resource persons from the field. More than 250 participants enrolled and attended the FDP.
