The principal objective of the seminar was to raise public awareness of the risks associated with social media and cybercrimes associated with financial fraud.

Dr Kavita Arora welcomed the audience & Dr Mukta Rohatgi spoke a few words of appreciation. The speaker also discussed how people fall in the trap of cyber fraud. He shared several online fraud cases such as Credit Card Fraud, KYC update fraud, BSES electricity bill fraud, etc. He stated that Luring plays a major role in cyber frauds. Always ask yourself a question: "Why only I got selected?" before believing in any online message or call.

The seminar ended on a positive note and was a successful one with the constant support of our respected Principal Sir, Prof. Rabi Narayan Kar.
