### Detailed Report:

The Department of History, Shyam Lal College under the aegis of its Sangam Society organised an intra-college quiz competition on the topic: "**Indian National Movement**" on 7th March, 2024 in Room No. 102, New Building. The aim of the quiz competition was to provide a healthy platform for the students of our college to participate, compete and showcase their knowledge and grasp on a very glorious and interesting chapter of modern Indian history which is held to have played a seminal role in founding India as a modern nation. The quiz competition was intended as a game mechanics into the learning process of the students that would enable them to check their grasp over the subject and motivate them to study more on this interesting topic. The above program also provided student volunteers of our Department an opportunity to learn and frame questions through critical study of the study material, learn to work in collaboration, teamwork and develop communication, management and other soft skills.

The competition was organised under the guidance of organising committee which included Dr. Rohan Mandal, Dr. Upendra Kumar and Dr. Dipak Kumar Shukla while Sh. Pankaj Kumar Chaudhary acted as a member of the Jury.

The Quiz Competition began at 10:00 a.m. and was held in three rounds. In all 112 students had registered online for participation out of which 55 students appeared for participation on the day of the event. The programme was conducted by quiz masters Parivesh Dhakar and Ashi Bhardwaj of B.A. History Honours Ist Yr. and were assisted by a team of student volunteers.

In the Elimination Round (Round I), all the participants were given a list of 30 questions to be answered in 15 minutes. In next Round II, the twenty one qualified candidates were organised in seven groups, each of which were asked five audio-visual questions displayed on the screen. The Final Round (Round III) was an individual round formed by dismantling the two qualifying groups of the previous round. In this round each of eight candidates were asked five questions carrying negative marks and due to thrilling tie for 3rd & 4th place, a set of 5 more questions were asked to the tied up groups to decide the last winner and the consolation prize winner.
