IQAC in Collaboration with CRPHE, NIEPA on ‘Educational

Opportunities in UK’

Internal quality assessment cell (IQAC) of Shyam Lal College, University of Delhi organized a seminar related to navigate 'The UK Postgraduate Education System' from 10th-13th May 2023. Shyam Lal College, is a part of an ongoing project related to higher education institutions research, titled ‘Widening access to the higher education in India Institutional approaches’ jointly undertaken by the University of Warwick and CRPHE – NIEPA.

Prof. Kusha Tiwari, Director, IQAC, SLC welcomed the Guests (Professors of the University of Warwick), the teachers and the students. She gave a brief introduction of the project started by our college.

The guests wanted to introduce themselves on their own. Prof. Ann Stewart started the seminar by introducing herself that she is the Professor of Law in the University of Warwick. Dr. Emily Henderson also gave her introduction that she is in the Department of Educational Studies, University of Warwick.

On the first day, they conducted a survey with issues relating to higher education with about 100 students and the faculty members. The survey consisted of a set of questions which had topics like the rural-urban focus of the institution, personal details of an individual, understanding of general concepts of sexual orientation,

educational qualification of the family members and the concluding remarks of a person.

On the second day, Dr. Emily Henderson talked about the small but the large reputed UK country. She tried to bring a contrast between the education systems in India and the UK. She talked about the private & public universities in the UK and gave the classification of that universities i.e. Russell Group, University Alliance & Million+ Group. Then she discussed the consideration for Postgraduate studies, the scholarships provided in the UK and options to consider for the UK as a study circle base. She talked about the general context of PG courses in the UK.

Prof. Anne Stewart introduced the University of Warwick. She discussed how the students can search for a good university to study in the UK. She spoke about the website of universities based in the UK. She also gave the live demo using the website of University of Warwick.

It was a completely interactive session as students asked the queries and doubts about the scope and future of the PG courses in the UK. Prof. Anne Stewart and Dr. Emily Henderson gave all the answers and solved their queries.

At last, Prof. Anne Stewart and Dr. Emily Henderson thanked the Principal, Professor Rabi Narayan Kar for the opportunity and the students who were present there.

On the third day, the faculty members were invited for an interaction session with the international guests.

The vote of thanks was given by Prof. Nartam Vivekanand Moitram to the guests, teachers and students.

It was an insightful session with the international guests, a few teachers and 50-60 students. Everyone acquired a large amount of information such as universities, fee structure, options and courses to study in the UK. The students and the faculty will
